- **Karapan Sapi:** It is a traditional bull race event from Madura Island in east Java. Kerapan derives from "kerap" or "kirap", meaning depart, released together or droves. But other version says that Kerapan derives from Arabic term "kirabah" and "sapi", meaning friendship, and bull respectively. The race event starts by a parade of the couple of bulls that participate on the race. Bulls are dressed in appealing ornamented decoration. Madurese traditional music Seronen, will make the parade more spirited and rousing.
- **Shopping:** Enjoy free time shopping local products like clothes, Madura souvenirs and crackers around Suramadu region.
