Keeping Healthy in Morocco

No vaccinations are required for Morocco. While there is a limited risk of Malaria in some parts of rural Morocco (remote areas of the sub-Saharan desert), it's not recommended to take anti-malarial drugs for travelers following standard city-based itineraries.

Morocco has a diverse geography, from the cooler, wetter Mediterranean and Atlantic coast in the north, to the desperately hot, arid deserts and mountains of the south. You can encounter a wide range of climatic conditions and you should be prepared.

Weather

Best Season to Travel

March, April, May, part of June, September & October - perfect warm temperatures (25 to 35 degrees Celsius) in the south, very little chance of rain and warm evenings, except in March and early April where evenings and mornings can be cooler (13° to 17°C).

Shoulder Season (winter)

Mid November to Mid-February is mostly warm (15 to 25 degrees Celsius) but can be very chilly in evenings and it may rain but rarely for long periods.

Hot Season (summer)

Mid-June, July and August can be very hot in Marrakech and in the south (up to 45 degrees Celsius), but more pleasant in the mountains and on the coast.

What to Pack

- First and foremost, we recommend layers to add and remove according to the varying temperatures
- Blouses/shirts with long sleeves to protect you from sun
- Cotton t-shirts and tops
- Fleece/jumper for the evening, temperatures drop at night in the desert
- Long trousers for the evenings for the same reason
- Light walking shoes/boots for any activities in the desert or mountains
- Sun Hat, sun glasses, sunblock
- Women need a scarf to cover their head and shoulders entering Muslim sites.
- Plug adapter: Morocco use 127/220V 50Hz

Religion & Etiquette

Morocco is an Islamic country. The religion is an integral part of the culture. Morocco is a land of tolerance, where Jews, Christians and Muslims live together in peace.

Money

Currency

The local currency is the Dirham (MAD). Foreign currencies can be converted at most banks, but it's not wise to carry too much. Pounds Sterling, US Dollars or Euros can be changed into local currency at any hotel, airport or bureau de change.

ATMs and Banks

ATMs are installed in most towns providing a secure and cost-effective way to retrieve money from your bank account or credit card

Credit cards

MasterCard, Visa and American Express are widely accepted, even in some shops in the souks, particularly for carpets.

Return to the hotel breakfast. Take 4x4 to Erfoud to meet the driver and drive to Ouarzazate. Travel along a scenic route to reach Ouarzazate, the capital of dates. You will pass the picturesque and densely planted palm grove of Skoura and continue to the Valley of a Thousand Kasbahs. From Skoura, you will drive east towards Kelaa El Mgouna. The Valley of Roses (main growing season between April and mid-May). (It does not have the largest cultivation of Persian roses. You will reach the impressive Dades Valley with its high limestone cliffs, beautiful palm trees and the narrow river. Lunch at Restaurant. Then continue and venture into the Todra Gorges to admire its gigantic rock walls and it's even more impressive palm trees grove that hides a flowing river. Arrival Ouarzazate, check in to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

DAY 6: OUARZAZATE – AIT BEN HADDOU - MARRAKECH

Breakfast at the hotel. Discover the secrets of Ouarzazate. Your sightseeing tour will include a visit to the Kasbah of Taourirt. Travel through the impressive Atlas Mountains to reach the exciting and exotic city of Marrakech. Along the way, you will stop at the fortified village of Ait Ben Haddou, the most exotic and best-preserved Kasbah in the entire Atlas region. As you pass the Tizi n'Tichka pass, the highest in the region at 2,260 meters, you will stop to marvel at the views and take some pictures. Free time in Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou. Lunch at Restaurant. Then continue to Marrakech, check-in to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: MARRAKECH FULL DAY

Breakfast at the hotel, full day devoted to visit Marrakech, the Red City. The visit includes: the Majorelle Gardens (entrance), the Koutoubia Mosque, the Menara Gardens, and the Bahia Palace (entrance). Lunch at Restaurant. Continuation in the afternoon with the souks and neighborhoods of the artisans, who show a variety of subjects. Finish the visit with a stop at the famous Djemaa El Fna Square and take advantage of its animation. Return to hotel, dinner and overnight.

DAY 8: MARRAKECH - DEPARTURE

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Transfer on time to the airport for the return flight.
