

4 Days Siem Reap -Tonle Sap Lake -Angkor Tour

DAY1 ARRIVAL > SIEM REAP > TONLE SAP LAKE (B)

Arrive in Siem Reap International Airport with morning flight, meet & greet by our professional guide who will introduce you briefly history, culture and various aspects of Cambodia lives.

In afternoon, start your countryside tour to visit **floating village** on **Tonle Sap Great Lake**, the largest fresh-water basin in South-East Asia at **Kampong Pluck Village**. Cambodia's Great Lake is one of the geographical wonders of the world. Getting the **private sheltered boat ride** is the best way to explore how people's lives work and witness their daily activities, including fishing, schooling, selling their products by rowing their dugout around.

Taking a trip on a **cart drawn by oxen**, is an affordable and safe adventure, allowing you to conveniently explore the country side and the country's ancient civilization.

Directly transfer to hotel for check-in. Overnight stay at the hotel in Siem Reap.

DAY2 SIEM REAP > ANGKOR TOUR (B)

Breakfast in hotel, transfer to **South Gate of Angkor Thom**, visit **Bayon Temple** located at the centre of Angkor Thom City. It is known for the 216 giant mysterious faces carve on the 54 towers, each posing a differing mysterious smile, keeping watch of each compass point. On the walls of the galleries are many bas-reliefs depicting scenes of everyday life, great battles and military processions during Angkor period and **Phimean Akas, Baphuon, Elephant and Leper King Terraces**.

End your day to visit one of the most popular temples of the Angkor Complex - **Ta Prohm Temple**. Like the Preah Khan, this Temple was built in the memory of the King Jayavarman VII's mother. When found by the French conservators at the end of the 19th century, they deliberately left this temple in the same condition as it was discovered.

We explore the intricately carved Khmer ruins at **Angkor Wat Temple**, and surrounding sites. This is the largest temple complex in the world, a marvel of art and architecture, both **Hindu and Buddhist**. End of your day, enjoy the **Sunset over Angkor Wat Temple**.

Overnight stays at hotel in Siem Reap.

DAY3 SIEM REAP > BANTEAY SREI > SOMBAI TOUR (B)

Breakfast in hotel, transfer to visit the pink stone of **Banteay Srei temple**, and **Banteay Samré**. Next visit the **Akira Landmine Museum** where you'll see deactivated landmines and learn about the consequences of war. Back to city stop at **sugar palm** factories and test its products.

In afternoon, visit **Prasat Kravan** (with its unique brick sculpture), the "Mountain Temple" of **Pré Rup**, **Eastern Mebon**, **Neak Pean** (a fountain built in the middle of a pool, representing the paradisiacal Himalayan mountain-lake), and **Preah Khan** built by King Jayavarman VII, Preah Khan is a place of towered enclosure and shoulder-hugging corridors. End your day at **Banteay Kdei**, **Srah Srang** a Royal bathing place.

Late afternoon, start a **Culinary Adventure of Khmer street food by Tuk Tuk** (2pax per Tuk Tuk), you will then start at Road No. 60, is like going for exploring and learning about local food, Cambodian style. A long road lined with mats for hire, street food sellers and a small fun fair, it's an evening picnic and barbecue haven. This is truly a local hang out with an incredible variety of all kinds of Khmer foods on offer. Here you will sample a range of exotic fruits, **fried insects, snails, roasted frog, fried chicken, roast belly pork, crispy duck and fried chive cakes**. After that, visit a local Cambodia wine workshop, known as "Sombai" you can visit and the owners will explain to you the process of rice wine distillation.

Finishing the night your guide can either drop you back off at your hotel or onto Pub Street to continue the night.

Overnight stays at hotel in Siem Reap.

DAY4 SIEM REAP > DEPARTURE (B)

Breakfast in hotel, free at leisure before transfer out to airport to catch your departure flight to next destination.
