

## 6 Days Discovery Phnom Penh - Siem Reap

### DAY1 ARRIVAL > PHNOM PENH

Arrive in Phnom Penh International Airport with afternoon flight, meet & greet by our professional guide who will introduce you briefly history, culture and various aspects of Cambodia lives. Directly transfer to hotel for check-in.

Late afternoon, Visit to **Wat Phnom**, where the city was founded on a small hilltop, the city's first pagoda was erected here in 1373 at the behest of the city's founder, Madame Daun Penh.

Enjoy 60-minutes **Enjoy sunset cruise** on Mekong River. Overnight at Hotel in Phnom Penh.

### DAY2 PHNOM PENH > CITY TOUR

(B)

Breakfast at hotel, city tour starting with **The Royal Palace**, which was built in 1866 by King Norodom. The Palace is made up from a number of structures within a pagoda-style compound one of which is **The Silver Pagoda**. The Silver Pagoda takes its name from the 5,000+ silver tiles and the building itself holds a number of national treasures.

Then visit **Independence Monument** and **Victory Monument** and former **King Norodom Sihanouk memorial Stupa**.

Free time for shopping at the **Central Market (Psa Thmey)**, located in a unique art deco building. Constructed in 1935, it's a Phnom Penh landmark.

In afternoon, visit **Champey Academy of Arts**, non-profit art professional school working to preserve, protect and promote Cambodian Culture. The school. The students are disadvantaged youth and appear to be genuinely pleased to perform for tourists.

Optional visit to **Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum (S-21)**, which was the largest center of incarceration and torture in the country during the Khmer Rouge regime. Continue to **Choeung Ek of Killing Field**, made famous by the film of the same name. It was where more than 17,000 civilians were killed and buried in mass graves; many of them were transported here after detention and torture in Toul Sleng. Overnight at Hotel in Phnom Penh.

**DAY3 PHNOM PENH > SIEM REAP BY LAND > TONLE SAP LAKE (B)**

Breakfast in hotel, then checkout and transfer by private vehicle for direction to Siem Reap, Angkor Empire. (*Domestic flight as supplement*)

On the way stop at **Skun**, a village famous throughout country for its delicacy of **black giant spider “Aping”** which it is tasted roasted or fried.

Then stop is the **Naga-Bridge**, Jayavarman VII's wonderful laterite bridge - **Kampong Kdei**, built in 12th century and now the condition still can carry about another 1,000 years on. The bridge is flanked by two finely carved nine-headed serpents.

Before reaching **Siem Reap**, transfer to visit **floating village** on **Tonle Sap Great Lake**, the largest fresh-water basin in South-East Asia at **Kampong Pluck Village**. Cambodia's Great Lake is one of the geographical wonders of the world. Getting the **private sheltered boat** ride is the best way to explore how people's lives work and witness their daily activities, including fishing, schooling, selling their products by rowing their dugout around.

Taking a trip, on a **cart drawn by oxen**, is an affordable and safe adventure, allowing you to conveniently explore the country side and the country's ancient civilization.

Directly transfer to hotel for check-in. Overnight stay at the hotel in Siem Reap.

**DAY4 SIEM REAP > ANGKOR TOUR (B)**

Breakfast in hotel, transfer to **South Gate of Angkor Thom**, visit **Bayon Temple** located at the centre of Angkor Thom City. It is known for the 216 giant mysterious faces carve on the 54 towers, each posing a differing mysterious smile, keeping watch of each compass point. On the walls of the galleries are many bas-reliefs depicting scenes of everyday life, great battles and military processions during Angkor period and **Phimean Akas, Baphuon, Elephant and Leper King Terraces**.

End your day to visit one of the most popular temples of the Angkor Complex - **Ta Prohm Temple**. Like the Preah Khan, this Temple was built in the memory of the King Jayavarman VII's mother. When found by the French conservators at the end of the 19th century, they deliberately left this temple in the same condition as it was discovered.

We explore the intricately carved Khmer ruins at **Angkor Wat Temple**, and surrounding sites. This is the largest temple complex in the world, a marvel of art and architecture, both **Hindu and Buddhist**. End of your day, enjoy the **Sunset over Angkor Wat Temple**.

Overnight stays at hotel in Siem Reap.

**DAY5 SIEM REAP > BANTEAY SREI > SOMBAI TOUR (B)**

Breakfast in hotel, transfer to visit the pink stone of **Banteay Srei temple**, and **Banteay Samré**. Next visit the **Akira Landmine Museum** where you'll see deactivated landmines and learn about the consequences of war. Back to city stop at **sugar palm** factories and test its products.

In afternoon, visit **Prasat Kravan** (with its unique brick sculpture), the “Mountain Temple” of **Pré Rup**, **Eastern Mebon**, **Neak Pean** (a fountain built in the middle of a pool, representing the paradisiacal Himalayan mountain-lake), and **Preah Khan** built by King Jayavarman VII, Preah Khan is a place of towered enclosure and shoulder-hugging corridors. End your day at **Banteay Kdei**, **Srah Srang** a Royal bathing place.

Late afternoon, start a **Culinary Adventure of Khmer street food by Tuk Tuk** (2pax per Tuk Tuk), you will then start at Road No. 60, is like going for exploring and learning about local food, Cambodian style. A long road lined with mats for hire, street food sellers and a small fun fair, it’s an evening picnic and barbecue haven. This is truly a local hang out with an incredible variety of all kinds of Khmer foods on offer. Here you will sample a range of exotic fruits, **fried insects, snails, roasted frog, fired chicken, roast belly pork, crispy duck and fried chive cakes**. After that, visit a local Cambodia wine workshop, known as “Sombai” you can visit and the owners will explain to you the process of rice wine distillation.

Finishing the night your guide can either drop you back off at your hotel or onto Pub Street to continue the night.

Overnight stays at hotel in Siem Reap.

**DAY6 SIEM REAP - DEPARTURE (B)**

Breakfast in hotel, free at leisure before transfer out to airport to catch your departure flight to next destination.
