- **Get to know:** Culture, History, Local living of people in Siem Reap City and Phnom Penh Capital. Enjoy Cambodia Cuisine. Experience Siem Reap, a resort town in northwestern Cambodia, is the gateway to the ruins of Angkor, the seat of the Khmer kingdom from the 9th–15th centuries. Angkor’s vast complex of intricate stone buildings includes preserved Angkor Wat, the main temple, which is pictured on Cambodia’s flag. Giant, mysterious faces are carved into the Bayon Temple at Angkor Thom. Discovery Phnom Penh, Cambodia’s busy capital, sits at the junction of the Mekong and Tonlé Sap rivers. It was a hub for both the Khmer Empire and French colonialists. On its walkable riverfront, lined with parks, restaurants and bars, are the ornate Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda and the National Museum, displaying artifacts from around the country. At the city’s heart is the massive, art deco Central Market.

SIGHTSEEINGS:



Artisan D'Angkor: a handicraft centre the Handicraft center for the wood and stone carving processes.



Wat Thmey (Killing Field): contains a unique glass-walled stupa containing the bones of victims of the Khmer Rouge.



Wat Memorial Mountain: it is dedicated to those who sacrificed their lives in the civil war.



South Gate of Angkor Thom: is famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone, the impressive Bayon Temple, the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King and the largest as well as the most complete temple of Angkor Wat. This architectural masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. We stroll around this massive

edifice, seeing the many galleries with Columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple.



Temple of Ta Prohm: There are enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers which embrace themselves in the stone foundations of the structure giving the impression of man's creation being reclaimed by the powerful forces of nature.



Angkor Wat: The “7th Wonders’ of the World” . World Heritage Site since 1992, famous for its beauty and splendor. Angkor Wat features the longest continuous bas-relief in the world, which runs along the outer gallery walls and narrates stories from Hindu mythology.



Bakheng Hill: is the first major temple to be constructed in the Angkor area, this temple-mountain offers extraordinary views of the Tonle Sap and Angkor Wat.



Naga Casino: is recognized as the finest integrated casino-hotel in Indochina, rivalling top Southeast Asian and world-renowned casinos. With a multi-faceted 8-storey wing dedicated to entertainment, the spirit of adventure is effervescent in the exquisitely themed public gaming halls, karaoke lounges and gaming machines. The combined offering of more than 500 luxurious Deluxe Rooms and plush Suites in the 14-storey Hotel Wing and a dedicated spa



The Royal Palace: is a magnificent example of Khmer architecture, it was built in 1866. You will see the Throne Hall and the Napoleon III Pavilion.



Silver Pagoda: is one of the city's most visited sites and offers a display of priceless Buddhist and historical objects. The Pagoda draws its name with more than 5,000 silver tiles, which cover a floor in the temple. The building serves less as a functioning shrine, no monks currently reside here, than a repository of cultural treasures such as the famous Emerald Buddha and many other valuable statues



Wat Phnom: is the tallest and most important temple in the Cambodian capital of Phnom Penh. The temple, first constructed in 1373, was erected on a man made, 88-foot-tall mound overlooking the city.



Independence Monument: An Angkorian style tower, the inimitable place in the whole city, located in the heart of the capital. It was built in 1958 to Sybilles Cambodian Independence Day after winning back their independence from the French protectorate on the 9th of November 1953.

Arrive at Siem Reap International Airport, met & greeted by Tour Guide. Transfer to hotel for checking in (Time of checking in is at 14h00). Then visit *Artisan D'Angkor, Wat Thmey or Killing Field* and *Wat Memorial Mountain*. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Upon arrival, visit *Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda* and *Wat Phnom*; Then visit **Chaktoumuk River front** on Sisowat Quay. Continue proceed to *Naga Casino* for visiting. After dinner, transfer for check in hotel. Overnight in Phnom Penh.
