On its walkable riverfront, lined with parks, restaurants and bars, are the ornate Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda and the National Museum, displaying artifacts from around the country. At the city's heart is the massive, art deco Central Market. Enjoy Cambodia Cuisine. Experience Siem Reap, a resort town in northwestern Cambodia, is the gateway to the ruins of Angkor, the seat of the Khmer kingdom from the 9th–15th centuries. Angkor's vast complex of intricate stone buildings includes preserved Angkor Wat, the main temple, which is pictured on Cambodia's flag. Giant, mysterious faces are carved into the Bayon Temple at Angkor Thom.

#### SIGHTSEEINGS



**The Royal Palace:** is a magnificent example of Khmer architecture, it was built in 1866. You will see the Throne Hall and the Napoleon III Pavilion.





**Silver Pagoda:** is one of the city's most visited sites and offers a display of priceless Buddhist and historical objects. The Pagoda draws its name with more than 5,000 silver tiles, which cover a floor in the temple. The building serves less as a functioning shrine, no monks currently reside here, than a repository of cultural treasures such as the famous Emerald Buddha and many other valuable statues.

National Museum: Located just north of the Royal Palace, the National Museum of Cambodia is housed in a graceful terracotta structure of traditional design (built from 1917 to 1920), with an inviting courtyard garden. The museum is home to the world's finest collection of Khmer sculpture – a millennium's worth and more of masterful Khmer design. The museum comprises four pavilions, facing a pretty garden. Most visitors start left and continue in a clockwise, chronological direction.



Wat Thmey (Killing Field): contains a unique glass-walled stupa containing the bones of victims of the Khmer Rouge.



Wat Phnom: is the tallest and most important temple in the Cambodian capital of Phnom Penh. The temple, first constructed in 1373, was erected on a man made, 88-foot-tall mound overlooking the city.



Roluos Group: Roluos is a village with a group of monuments anterior to those in Angkor. The Roluos group is what has remained from the ancient Hariharalaya, which was the first significant capital during the Khmer Empire of the Angkorian era.



Angkor Wat: The "7th Wonders' of the World". World Heritage Site since 1992, famous for its beauty and splendor. Angkor Wat features the longest continuous bas-relief in the world, which runs along the outer gallery walls and narrates stories from Hindu mythology.



**South Gate of Angkor Thom:** is famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone, the impressive Bayon Temple, the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King and the largest as well as the most complete temple of Angkor Wat. This architectural masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. We stroll around this massive edifice, seeing the many galleries with Colums, libraries,

pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple.



**Prasat Kravan:** is located in the east of Angkor Wat (southern route of the small circuit). Bas-reliefs of Vishnu and Lakshmi are rendered into the brick, the only example of brick bas-reliefs in the Angkor area.



Choueng Kneas Village: is a famous floating village where explore the different of Khmer, Muslim and Vietnamese floating households and the floating markets, fisheries, clinics, schools, basketball course, pigsty and other boatloads of tourists.



The Tonle Sap Lake (otherwise known as the Great Lake): is a combined lake and river system in Cambodia. It is the largest fresh water lake in Southeast Asia and the richest fishing lake in the World. It has been designated a UNESCO Biosphere.

## ITINERARY:

## DAY 01: PHNOM PENH ARRIVAL



Arrive at Phnom Penh International Airport, met & greeted by Tour Guide and transfer to the hotel (Time of checking in is at 14h00). Then visit *Royal Palace* which is actually a number of structures within a pagoda-style compound, *Silver Pagoda*, one of the city's most visited sites and offers a display of priceless Buddhist and historical objects and *National Museum of Khmer Arts*, one of the world's greatest collections of Khmer cultural material including sculpture, ceramics and ethnographic objects from the prehistoric, pre-Angkorian, Angkorian and post-Angkorian periods.

In the afternoon, visit *Killing Field of Choeung Ek* and *The Tuol Sleng Museum of Genocidal Crime* to witness the reign of terror. Before back to hotel, visit famous *Wat Phnom.* Overnight in Phnom Penh.
