Experience Siem Reap, a resort town in northwestern Cambodia, is the gateway to the ruins of Angkor, the seat of the Khmer kingdom from the 9th–15th centuries. Angkor’s vast complex of intricate stone buildings includes preserved Angkor Wat, the main temple, which is pictured on Cambodia’s flag. Giant, mysterious faces are carved into the Bayon Temple at Angkor Thom. Discovery Phnom Penh, Cambodia’s busy capital, sits at the junction of the Mekong and Tonlé Sap rivers. It was a hub for both the Khmer Empire and French colonialists. On its walkable riverfront, lined with parks, restaurants and bars, are the ornate Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda and the National Museum, displaying artifacts from around the country. At the city’s heart is the massive, art deco Central Market. Enjoy the beautiful beaches at Sihanoukville, Cambodia. Snuggle up and watch the sunset on the beach

SIGHTSEEINGS:



The Tonle Sap Lake (otherwise known as the Great Lake): is a combined lake and river system in Cambodia. It is the largest fresh water lake in Southeast Asia and the richest fishing lake in the World. It has been designated a UNESCO Biosphere.



Chong Kneas Village: is a famous floating village where explore the different of Khmer, Muslim and Vietnamese floating households and the floating markets, fisheries, clinics, schools, basketball course, pigsty and other boatloads of tourists.



Angkor Wat: The “7th Wonders’ of the World” . World Heritage Site since 1992, famous for its beauty and splendor. Angkor Wat features the longest continuous bas-relief in the world, which runs along the outer gallery walls and narrates stories from Hindu mythology.



South Gate of Angkor Thom: is famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone, the impressive Bayon Temple, the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King and the largest as well as the most complete temple of Angkor Wat. This architectural masterpiece was constructed in the 12th century and covers an area of about 210 hectares. We stroll around this massive edifice, seeing the many galleries with Columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple.



National Museum: Located just north of the Royal Palace, the National Museum of Cambodia is housed in a graceful terracotta structure of traditional design (built from 1917 to 1920), with an inviting courtyard garden. The museum is home to the world’s finest collection of Khmer sculpture – a millennium’s worth and more of masterful Khmer design. The museum comprises four pavilions, facing a pretty garden. Most visitors start left and continue in a clockwise, chronological direction.



Independence Monument: An Angkorian style tower, the inimitable place in the whole city, located in the heart of the capital. It was built in 1958 to Sybilles Cambodian Independence Day after winning back their independence from the French protectorate on the 9th of November 1953.



Wat Thmey (Killing Field): contains a unique glass-walled stupa containing the bones of victims of the Khmer Rouge.



The Royal Palace: is a magnificent example of Khmer architecture, it was built in 1866. You will see the Throne Hall and the Napoleon III Pavilion.



Silver Pagoda: is one of the city's most visited sites and offers a display of priceless Buddhist and historical objects. The Pagoda draws its name with more than 5,000 silver tiles, which cover a floor in the temple. The building serves less as a functioning shrine, no monks currently reside here, than a repository of cultural treasures such as the famous Emerald Buddha and many other valuable statues



Wat Phnom: is the tallest and most important temple in the Cambodian capital of Phnom Penh. The temple, first constructed in 1373, was erected on a man made, 88-foot-tall mound overlooking the city.



Wat Leu: Wat Leu, Sihanoukville is not only a religious and historic site it is also significant from the architectural point of view. Sihanoukville Wat Leu is surrounded by a high stone wall. There is a three headed white elephant beautifully carved out of the stone wall with three statues of Buddha on the three heads of the elephant. The golden colored temple with thatched roofs and traditional design resembles the pagodas.



Ream National Park: While there are many great sites to see in the country, Ream National Park in Cambodia is the crown jewel of them all. It is 81 square miles of incredible sights and sounds that you will never forget. The park begins on the mainland of Cambodia, but includes the water that surrounds the peninsula area of Sihanoukville, as well as 21 islands that come with their own tales and adventures you can enjoy.

DAY 01: SIEM REAP ARRIVAL

Arrive at Siem Reap International Airport, met & greeted by Tour Guide and transfer to the hotel (Time of checking in is at 14h00).

In the afternoon, visit ***an ethnic local village*** and take a scenic boat cruise on the ***Tonle Sap Lake***, the world's largest inland freshwater lake, to see ***the Floating Village***. Desembark and back to Siem Reap for overnight.
