**SIGHTSEEINGS:**



**The Royal Palace:** is a magnificent example of Khmer architecture, it was built in 1866. You will see the Throne Hall and the Napoleon III Pavilion.



**Silver Pagoda:** is one of the city's most visited sites and offers a display of priceless Buddhist and historical objects. The Pagoda draws its name with more than 5,000 silver tiles, which cover a floor in the temple. The building serves less as a functioning shrine, no monks currently reside here, than a repository of cultural treasures such as the famous Emerald Buddha and many other valuable statues



**Wat Phnom:** is the tallest and most important temple in the Cambodian capital of Phnom Penh. The temple, first constructed in 1373, was erected on a man made, 88-foot-tall mound overlooking the city.



**Independence Monument:** An Angkorian style tower, the inimitable place in the whole city, located in the heart of the capital. It was built in 1958 to Sybilles Cambodian Independence Day after winning back their independence from the French protectorate on the 9th of November 1953.



**Russian Market:** is the most popular market among tourists and expats and probably the best place to pick up souvenirs. It does not look like much from the outside but when you get in you will find everything from beautifully hand carved statues, colorful lanterns and handmade silk scarves to fake bags, printed T-shirts and DVDs.

### DAY 01: PHNOM PENH ARRIVAL

Arrive at Phnom Penh International Airport, met & greeted by Tour Guide. We visit *Independence Monument, Royal Palace* and *the Silver Pagoda*. Transfer to hotel for checking in (Time of checking in is at 14h00). In the afternoon, sightseeing *Toul Sleng Museum* and *Wat Phnom Temple*. Overnight in Phnom Penh.
