## SIGHTSEEINGS:



**Qurban** is an Islamic ceremony for slotting Cow, Goat and sheep. It is always done in Raya Aidil adha day. **Raya Aidil adha** is the main Islamic religion ceremony that millions of Muslims have to go to Mecca to perform the Hajj at Saudi Arabia every year, requirement 1-only in Islam,2-rich family and 3-who have good enough health , to perform the Hajj at least one time in her/his lifetime because It is a 5th Pillar of Islamic religion.



**Tuol Sleng** is Cambodia's most notorious prison - in the 1970s, at least 12,000 people were tortured there and murdered. Only a handful of prisoners survived but now, 40 years after Pol Pot took control of the country, two of them return to the cells every day to remind people what happened.



**The Royal Palace:** is a magnificent example of Khmer architecture, it was built in 1866. You will see the Throne Hall and the Napoleon III Pavilion.

**Russian Market:** is the most popular market among tourists and expats and probably the best place to pick up souvenirs. It does not look like much from the outside but when you get in you will find everything from beautifully hand carved statues, colorful lanterns and handmade silk scarves to fake bags, printed T-shirts and DVDs.



## ITINERARY:

### DAY 01: PHNOM PENH ARRIVAL KAMPONG CHAM

Upon arrival at Phnom Penh International Airport, our professional tour guide will meet and greet, then proceed directly to Kompong Cham, which have many Muslim Village. Overnight at Kompong (02 Pax stay in one house). Guest will stay with MalayuChampa family to learn about the life style of local villager.

### DAY 02: KAMPONG CHAM QURBAN ACTIVITY

Wake up early morning for Eid-Adha Praying at Masjid. One Kodbah finish, experience with sharing some Sodakoh to children which Kompong people always practices. Then proceed to Qurban Place. You will be welcome by Imam and start Qurban Ceremony ( **arrange by your expense** ). Enjoy lunch. Overnight at Kompong.

### DAY 03: KAMPONG CHAM PHNOM PENH

This morning, we will transfer to Phnom Penh, Lunch at Muslim restaurant. Check in hotel, relax then continue to visit some interesting places. You will start your first visit the haunting and harrowing *Toul Sleng museum*. This is situated in central Phnom Penh in a former school building. The school was used as a prison during the rule of Pol Pot and the Khmer Rouge and has been left as a reminder for future generations and then visit *Cheung Ek Killing field* (15Km from Phnom Penh).

Late afternoon, *sunset cruise* on the river (1hour). We set off on the *Tonle Sap River*, which famously reverses direction each year, acting as the world's largest natural flood barrier for the *Mekong River*. We cruise past the *Royal Palace* compound and around the *ChrouyChangvar Peninsular* on to the mighty Mekong River. We cruise past small

villages and see fishing boats preparing their catch. Back to hotel, free on your own. Overnight in Phnom Penh
