Cambodia Package Tour 7Days/6Nights Option II

DAY 01 ARRIVAL - SIEM REAP - CITY TOUR (L/D)

After you arriving at Siem Reap airport, you will welcome by our guide and driver Next, in the center,

hundreds of people streamed in and out of a small alcove where stately brass and bronze statues of **Preah Ang Chek and Ang Chom stood**. These sister deities, believed to have been Angkorean princesses, originally stood in the gallery of One Thousand Buddhas at Angkor Wat, however successive generations of monks moved them repeatedly to keep their whereabouts secret from invaders and treasure hunters, until they were finally enshrined in their current location in 1990.

We will start to visit **Wat Thmey** then, Continue **visit War Memorial Monument**.

Lunch at local restaurant

Check in hotel for refreshment.

This afternoon, we enjoy do shopping around **old market**.

Then, we will go to visit the **Silk Farm in Puk District** (18 Km from town) where can see the whole process of making silk from the center.

Breakfast at hotel




08:00am - pick up from your hotel. We visit the immense walled city of **Angkor Thom** that was the

masterpiece of King Jayavarman VII. Following the occupation of Angkor by the Chams from 1177 to 1181, the new king decided to build an impregnable fortress at the heart of his empire. Then we begin our visit at the **Terrace of the Leper King**. This intricately carved platform was the royal crematorium and the statue that was originally thought to be the leper king is now believed to be Yama, the god of death. We continue along the **Terrace of Elephants**, At the southern end lies the **Baphuon**, once of the most beautiful temples at Angkor, dating from the reign of Uditayavarman in the 11th century. Our climax is the enigmatic and enchanting temple of the **Bayon**.



Lunch at local restaurant



This afternoon, we journey out to the jungle temple **Ta Prohm** where Tomb Raider was filmed. Ta Prohm

has been abandoned to the elements, a reminder that while empires rise and fall, the riotous power of nature marches on, oblivious to the dramas of human history. Then, we continue to the Mother of all temples, **Angkor Wat**. Believed to be the world's largest religious building, this temple is the perfect fusion of symbolism and symmetry and a source of pride and strength to all Khmers. Built in the 12th century by King Suryavarman II, this is most famous temple at Angkor.



Then view sunset from **Bakheng Mountain**.

Remark: Due to authority set new rule Bakheng Hill allow only 300tourists claim up each time so normally we need to be there around 04:00PM.

DAY 03 SIEM REAP - BAOT TRIP TO TONLE SAP - PHNOM PENH (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel

08:30am - in the morning, you will visit at **Floating Village (Tonle Sap)**. The Tonle Sap Lake, fed by

the mighty Menkong and the Tonle Sap River, is a vast expanse of water that forms the most significant topographical feature in Cambodia.

Lunch at local restaurant

Then transfer you to Phnom Penh by bus, arrival dinner at local restaurant then check in hotel for overnight.

On the way from the Kompong Thom to Kompong Cham we we will stop to visit at Skunn Market where people sale Spider for local they eat..!Cove and water buffalo and stone covering local business on the way. Best spot..!

Overnight in Phnom Penh

DAY 04 PHNOM PENH - CITY TOUR (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel

08:30am - we explore the stunning **Royal Palace** complex, home to the Cambodian royal family and a

symbol of the nation. We begin amid the beautiful royal gardens, landscaped with tropical plants and studded with gleaming spires. We enter the Throne Hall where the royal receptions are held and the Cambodian king's coronation took place. We then pass the Napoleon III Pavilion made from iron, a gift from the French emperor in the 19th century. We continue to the Silver Pagoda, named after the 5000 silver tiles covering the floor, each weighing 1kg. Inside are some of the country's most cherished treasures, including a





life-size gold Buddha studded with 9584 diamonds, the largest weighing 25 carats.

Then, we come face to face with the horrific crimes of the Khmer Rouge. **Tuol Sleng** was a former high school that the Khmer Rouge turned into a centre for interrogation, torture and death.

Lunch at local restaurant

Then visit the **independent monument**, **King Morodom Statue & Chaktomuk Riverside.**

Afternoon, we travel to the **Russian Market**, one of the premier shopping destinations in the Cambodian capital. Known as Psar Tuol Tom Pong, it earned its nickname in the 1980s, when Russians were the only tourists in Cambodia. A rambling place, it is bursting with bargains, including handicrafts, carvings, silk and textiles, clothing and footwear, and lots of pirated software, CDs and DVDs, not forgetting enough motorcycle parts to assemble a homemade moped.

Free at **Naga World** which is the biggest Casino in Cambodia.

In the late afternoon, we board a local boat for a **sunset cruise** on the river. We set off on the **Tonle Sap River**, which famously reverses direction each year, acting as the world's largest natural flood barrier for the **Mekong River**. We cruise past the **Royal Palace** compound and around the **Chrouy Changvar Peninsular** on to the mighty Mekong River. We cruise past small villages and see fishing boats preparing their catch. We return to Phnom Penh after dark.

DAY 05 PHNOM PENH - SIHANOUK VILLE - CITY TOUR (B/L/D)

07:00am – we leave to Sihanouk Ville by bus, arrival will lunch at local restaurant then check in hotel for refreshment.

Afternoon visit Tumnuk Rolok fishing port and its surrounding **fishing villages** in Sihanoukville (Kampong Som) Cambodia is an interesting place to visit.

Later afternoon, vsist **Wat Krom** is a Buddhist temple located on a small hill on Santipheap Street where about 3 kilometers from the provincial town of

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<u>Sihanoukville</u>. <u>Wat Krom temple</u> is one of the most popular tourists <u>attraction</u> <u>in Cambodia</u> because it is not only has a unique and beautiful architecture but also has a charming view over Sihanoukville and the sea. The temple was built to dedicate to the local deity Yeah Mao and because it is a holly place, so when you entering, please remember to follow these tips:

DAY 06 PRINCE ISLAND & REAM NATIONAL PARK TOUR (B/L/D)

International Tourism Resort in Ream National Park of Sihanouk ville home. • We travel out to Mangrove River, located in the north about 15 km of Ream National Park. Stopping along the way for the chance to visit the immense tree and take photos know as Chum Bok. We then continue to Mangrove River and walk through to the first great in the natural forest and passing through on the wooden bridge to view of natural forest. • We reach Prince Island (Sam Pouch Island) and then enjoy walking on the great wooden bridge around this island and we can be to take photos, swimming and leave the rest of the day free to enjoy the beautiful beaches.

Lunch at local restaurant. • After lunch, visit to Ream National Park.

food, the building of this market is a well -known landmark in town. You also can find some local souvenirs in this market. However, the Phsar Leu Market closes by 7 in the evening everyday so make sure you don't get disappointed.
