DAY 01 SINGAPORE - SIEM REAP – CITY TOUR (L/D)

After you arriving at Siem Reap airport, you will welcome by our guide and driver We will start to visit **Wat Preah Prom Rath** then, Continue **War Museum** Cambodia is located at Siem Reap in Cambodia, near National Highway No. 6 between the city of Siem Reap and the International Airport. The purpose of this museum is to keep the memory of the civil war in the history of Cambodia alive and to preserve the unique collection for posterity.

Next, in the center, hundreds of people streamed in and out of a small alcove where stately brass and bronze statues of **Preah Ang Chek and Ang Chom stood**. These sister deities, believed to have been Angkorean princesses, originally stood in the gallery of One Thousand Buddhas at Angkor Wat, however successive generations of monks moved them repeatedly to keep their whereabouts secret from invaders and treasure hunters, until they were finally enshrined in their current location in 1990.

Lunch at local restaurant then check in hotel for refreshment.

This afternoon, we enjoy do shopping around **old market**.

Then, we will go to visit the **Silk Farm in Puk District** (18 Km from town) where can see the whole process of making silk from the center.

DAY 02 SIEM REAP – ANGKO THOM - ANGKOR WAT - TA PROHM (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel

08:00am - in the morning, Pick up from your hotel. We visit the immense walled city of **Angkor Thom** that was the masterpiece of King Jayavarman VII. Following the occupation of Angkor by the Chams from 1177 to 1181, the new king decided to build an impregnable fortress at the heart of his empire. Then we begin our visit at the **Terrace of the Leper King**. This intricately carved platform was the royal crematorium and the statue that was originally thought to be the leper king is now believed to be Yama, the god of death. We continue along the **Terrace of Elephants**,. At the southern end lies the **Baphuon**, once of the most beautiful temples at Angkor, dating from the reign of Uditayavarman in the 11th century. Our climax is the enigmatic and enchanting temple of the **Bayon**.

Lunch at local restaurant

This afternoon, we journey out to the jungle temple **Ta Prohm** where Tomb Raider was filmed. Ta Prohm has been abandoned to the elements, a reminder that while empires rise and fall, the riotous power of nature marches on, oblivious to the dramas of human history. Then, we continue to the Mother of all temples, **Angkor Wat**. Believed to be the world's largest religious building, this temple is the perfect fusion of symbolism and symmetry and a source of pride and strength to all Khmers. Built in the 12th century by King Suryavarman II, this is most famous temple at Angkor.

And view sun set at **Bakheng Mountain**.

Remark: Due to authority set new rule Bakheng Hill allow only 300tourists claim up each time so normally we need to be there around 04:00PM.

DAY 03 SIEM REAP – PHNOM KULEN MOUNTAIN (B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel

08:00am - this morning we travel to **Phnom Kulen**, the sacred mountain that was the birthplace of the Khmer empire. It was here that Jayavarman II proclaimed independence from Java in 802, setting the stage for the glories of the Angkor-era that was to follow. This mountain plateau was the capital of the Khmer empire before it relocated south to Hariharalaya, known today as Roluos.

Lunch at local restaurant

Wat Pre Ang Thom is a focus of pilgrimage for Khmers during religious festivals and the large reclining Buddha carved into a huge sandstone boulder here offers spectacular views across the lush jungle.

Nearby are impressive riverbed rock carvings, including innumerable **1000 lingas** and representations of **Shiva** and **Vishnu**. There is a classic **waterfall** further downstream which the perfect place to cool off after exploring is and nearby is a small, jungle-clad temple called **Prasat Krau Romeas**. We enjoy a picnic lunch before descending from the plateau.

Late Afternoon will return to Siem Reap town and **a short visit one local village names Banteay Srey Village** to see inhabitants make natural palm sugar and other daily usage products

Visit **Road 60 Meters** which is the popular market for local people

Dinner with apsara dance show at local restaurant
Overnight in Siem Reap



DAY 04 SIEMREAP – BOAT TRIP TONLE SAP – SINGAPORE (B/L)

Breakfast at hotel

08:30am - in the morning, you will visit at **Floating Village (Tonle Sap)**. The Tonle Sap Lake, fed by the mighty Menkong and the Tonle Sap River, is a vast expanse of water that forms the most significant topographical feature in Cambodia.
