# **5 DAYS PHNOM PEHN & SIEM REAP PACKAGE TOUR**

## DAY 01 SINGAPORE - PHNOM PENH - CITY TOUR (L/D)

After you arriving at Phnom Penh airport, warmly welcome by our guide and driver then lunch at local restaurant

Check in hotel for refreshment.

We explore the stunning **Royal Palace** complex, home to the Cambodian royal family and a symbol of the nation. We begin amid the beautiful royal gardens, landscaped with tropical plants and studded with gleaming spires. We enter the **Throne Hall** where the royal receptions are held and the Cambodian king's coronation took place. We then pass the **Napoleon III Pavilion** made from iron, a gift from the French emperor in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. We continue to the **Silver Pagoda**, named after the 5000 silver tiles covering the floor, each weighing 1kg. Inside are some of the country's most cherished treasures, including a life-size gold Buddha studded with 9584 diamonds, the largest weighing 25 carats.

Then visit to independent monument, King Morodom Statue & Chaktomuk Riverside.

Next free at visit **Naga World** which is the biggest Casino in Cambodia.

## DAY 02 PHNOM PENH - CITY TOUR (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel

**08:30am -** this morning, we then travel out of town to the **Killing Fields of Choeng Ek**. Prisoners from Tuol Sleng followed this same route to their fate. An old Chinese cemetery, Choeng Ek was turned into an extermination camp for political prisoners. The remains of 8985 people were exhumed from mass graves and are kept in a memorial stupa here.

Then free at Aeon Super Market which is the best & biggest mall in Cambodia

Lunch at local restaurant

Afternoon, we come face to face with the horrific crimes of the Khmer Rouge. **Tuol Sleng** was a former high school that the Khmer Rouge turned into a centre for interrogation, torture and death. Today it is a museum of torture and serves to remind visitors of the terrible atrocities that came to pass in Cambodia. 17,000 people passed through the gates of this prison and only seven lived to tell the tale. Experience and not everyone will want to visit.

We travel to the **Russian Market**, one of the premier shopping destinations in the Cambodian capital. Known as Psar Tuol Tom Pong, it earned its nickname in the 1980s, when Russians were the only tourists in Cambodia. A rambling place, it is bursting with bargains, including handicrafts, carvings, silk and textiles, clothing and footwear, and lots of pirated software, CDs and DVDs, not forgetting enough motorcycle parts to assemble a homemade moped.

After some time here to browse or buy, we travel to the impressive Central Market, one of the city landmarks. Originally completed by the French in 1937, this striking structure is known as **Psar Thmei** in Khmer or New Market. The huge dome is wonderfully ventilated, a testament to the design, and this market is loaded with anything and everything available in Cambodia. Buy with caution, as this market has a reputation for overcharging or 'shaving your head' as Cambodians like to call it.

DAY 03 PHNOM PENH - SIEM REAP- CITY TOUR (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel

**07:00am -** this morning, we will transfer you to bus station for travelling to Siem Reap, arrival check in hotel then lunch at local restaurant

On the way from the Kompong Thom to Kompong Cham we we will stop to visit at **Skunn Market** where people sale Spider for local they eat..!Cove and water buffaloand stone covering local business on the way. best spot..!

Next, in the center, hundreds of people streamed in and out of a small alcove where stately brass and bronze statues of **Preah Ang Chek and Ang Chom stood**. These sister deities, believed to have been Angkorean princesses, originally stood in the gallery of One Thousand Buddhas at Angkor Wat, however successive generations of monks moved them repeatedly to keep their whereabouts secret from invaders and treasure hunters, until they were finally enshrined in their current location in 1990.

Then **Wat Preah Prom Rath** we enjoy do shopping around **old market**.

DAY 04 SIEM REAP - ANGKO THOM - ANGKOR WAT - TA PROHM (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel

**08:00am** - in the morning, Pick up from your hotel. We visit the immense walled city of **Angkor Thom** that was the masterpiece of King Jayavarman VII. Following the occupation of Angkor by the Chams from 1177 to 1181, the new king decided to build an impregnable fortress at the heart of his empire. Then we begin our visit at the **Terrace of the Leper King**. This intricately carved platform was the royal crematorium and the statue that was originally thought to be the leper king is now believed to be Yama, the god of death. We continue along the **Terrace of Elephants**,. At the southern end lies the **Baphuon**, once of the most beautiful temples at Angkor, dating from the reign of Uditayavarman in the 11<sup>th</sup> century. Our climax is the enigmatic and enchanting temple of the **Bayon**.

Lunch at local restaurant

This afternoon, we journey out to the jungle temple **Ta Prohm** where Tomb Raider was filmed. Ta Prohm has been abandoned to the elements, a reminder that while empires rise and fall, the riotous power of nature marches on, oblivious to the dramas of human history. Then, we continue to the Mother of all temples, **Angkor Wat**. Believed to be the world's largest religious building, this temple is the perfect fusion of symbolism and symmetry and a source of pride and strength to all Khmers. Built in the 12<sup>th</sup> century by King Suryavarman II, this is most famous temple at Angkor.

And view sun set at **Bakheng Mountain**.

**Remark:** Due to authority set new rule Bakheng Hill allow only 300tourists claim up each time so normally we need to be there around 04:00PM.
