DAY 01: SINGAPORE – PHNOM PENH (L/D)

Upon arrival at Phnom Penh airport, you will be greeted by our representative and transfer to visit the **Wat Phnom** is on the only 'hill' in town. According to legend, the first pagoda on this site was erected in 1373 to house four statues of Buddha deposited here by the waters of the Mekong River and discovered by Penh and after have lunch at local restaurant, we transfer you to check in your hotel. Afternoon, we visit the **Royal Palace**, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the **Silver Pagoda**. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles, the former **King Norodom Sihanouk** statue and the **Independence Monument** or **Vimean Ekareach** – as it is referred to in Khmer, is a majestic structure that dominates Phnom Penh city centre. Independence Monument was primarily erected to mark the liberation of the country from the French who ruled Cambodia for almost a century from 1863 to 1953 till enjoy **Sunset Dinner on Cruise** along the riverfront and overnight in Phnom Penh.

DAY 02: PHNOM PENH TOUR (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit to the Notorious **Tuol Sleng Museum**, In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21) and the **Killing Fields** are a number of sites in **Cambodia** where collectively more than a million people were killed and buried by the communist **Khmer Rouge** regime, during **its rule** of the country from 1975 to 1979, immediately after the end of the **Cambodian Civil War** (1970–1975). After lunch at local restaurant, we visit the **Central Market (Phsar Thmei)** in Phnom Penh is one of those busy bazaars that are always filled with effervescent crowd from one end to the other. The Central Market (Phsar Thmei) of Phnom Penh stocks everything right from food items to clothes, silverworks and jewelries then we enjoy **Traditional Dance Workshop at Experience Cambodian Living Arts** from 1500-1630 till have dinner at local restaurant and overnight in Phnom Penh.

DAY 03: PHNOM PENH – SIEM REAP (B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel, your guide will collect you from your hotel for the transfer by road to Siem Reap town. On the way, we'll make a stop to visit **Spider Market in Skun**. Skun is also known in the local language as "Spiderville" and visited by international visitors for its fried spiders. There were many trays with different types of fried bugs/insects, but the market is best known from the spiders or tarantulas. Today, we'll have lunch at local restaurant on the way at Prey Pros restaurant. Then, we visit the **old bridge of Kampong Kdei**, Angkorian period bridge and next where you will learn how the locals produce **Grolan (sticky rice stuffed in bamboo)** before check in your hotel. Tonight, we'll have dinner at local restaurant and overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 04: SIEM REAP (B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel, we visit the **Floating Village of Chong Khneas**. Chong Khneas is the name of famous floating village at the edge of the lake. You will explore the different of Khmer, Muslim and Vietnamese floating households and the floating markets, fisheries, clinics, schools, basketball course, pigsty and other boatloads of tourists and the **Angkor National Museum** for an hour's walk around this interactive insight into the history behind Angkor. After lunch at local restaurant, we visit the **Cambodian Cultural Village** where is designed to provide tourists with an excellent insight into the life and culture of the Cambodians; their traditions and practices, etc. until have dinner with **Apsara Dance Show** at local restaurant and overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 05: SIEM REAP (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to Angkor Thom Area (**Angkor Thom Temple South Gate, Bayon Temple, Baphuon Temple, Phimean Akas Temple, Elephants Terrace & Leper King Terrace, Royal Palace, Woman and Man Pond**). Proceed to visit **Ta-Prom Temple**. After lunch at local restaurant, we continue our journey to **Angkor Wat Temple** – one of the seven greatest architectural wonders of the world, built in between the 9th – 13th century till its beautiful **sunset**. We'll have dinner at local restaurant and overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 06: SIEM REAP – SINGAPORE (B/L)

After breakfast at hotel, we visit to **Angkor Silk Farm**. Our guides will give you more details on the mulberry trees, silkworm farming, cocoon unwinding, preparation of the silk threads, ikat technique (tie-dyeing of the threads) and silk weaving, the - **Chantiers Ecole** where visitors can observe students learning traditional carving and finishing techniques and **Old Market**. After have lunch at local restaurant, we transfer you to Siem Reap airport for your departure.
