### DAY 01: BANGKOK

(L/D)

Arrival in Bangkok, you will meet our representative and transferred by your flight.

Lunch at local restaurant after go to **Grand Palace & Wat Phra Kaew**. **The Grand Palace** was the seat not only of the king and his court, but contained within its crenellated walls the Entire government administration. The most famous building on the palace grounds is **Wat Phra Kaew** (Temple of the Emerald Buddha), regarded as the most sacred Buddhist temple (Wat) in Thailand. Construction of the temple began when King Rama I moved the capital from Thonburi to Bangkok in 1785. The main temple building is the central ubosoth, which houses the Emerald Buddha. Though green in color, the Buddha is actually carved from a single piece of jade, and though only 17 inches tall, is the most revered object in Thailand.

Finish tour, go to Gems Gallery Factory for shopping handicraft and gems before go to Check in at Hotel.

Dinner at Baiyoke Sky Hotel. (Inter Buffet Dinner)

Overnight at your choice. (Sharing twin bed)

### DAY 02: BANGKOK – AYUTTHAYA

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at your hotel.

**Ayutthaya Tour by Road incl. Lunch.** Among the "must see" attractions in Thailand is a visit to Ayutthaya, the former capital of Thailand, Ayutthaya is one of Thailand's major tourist attractions. Many ancient ruins and art works can be seen in the city, which was founded in 1350 by King U-Thong. 33 kings of 5 dynasties ruled the kingdom until it was destroyed by the Burmese in 1767. During this day trip you will visit the principal sights: Wat Sri Sanphet - this important and outstanding monastery was used as a presidential palace in the reign of King Ramathibodi I. Wat Phananchong: This monastery existed before Ayutthaya was founded as the capital. The principal 19 meters high Buddha image is made of stucco and is the most revered by the inhabitants of Ayutthaya. Wat Yai Chaimongkhon: The chedi at this monastery is among the largest in Ayutthaya and was built by King Naresuan (1590-1605). There are many Buddha images and a beautiful garden behind this chedi. This tour also includes a boat trip to Bang-Pa-In, the former Royal Summer Residence, which represents a fine example of Thai architecture.

After tour back to **Mbk Leisure for shopping and dinner at local restaurant.**

### DAY3: BANGKOK – FLOATING MARKET

Early Breakfast at the hotel. Depart to **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market**. Damnoen Saduak Floating Market in Ratchaburi province about 100km from Bangkok. Take a long tail boat ride through the canals and see how Thai people live alongside the labyrinth of canals in this area. Arrive at the famous Damnoen Saduak market where you can stroll around the colourful floating marketplace bustling with boats and vendors selling tropical fruits and other delights.

**Lunch at local restaurant.** Free at your own leisure. **Go to New Shopping Mall (Show Dc Shopping Mall),**
