Angkor Temple Highlights (Full day)

Visit the southern gate of Angkor Thom, which was built in the 12th century with intricate carvings depicting scenes from Hindu mythology. Move on to the Bayon temple complex, with its serene and enormous stone faces and onto the ancient Ta Prohm temple with trees growing out of the ruins against the jungle surroundings.

Next stop is Angkor Wat, an ancient temple complex, currently a UNESCO World Heritage Site, which depicts the epitome of the high classical style of Khmer architecture and also its significance as a religious centre. We conclude with a climb up Phnom Bakheng to watch the beautiful sunset.

Kulen mountain (Full day)

The Kulen Mountain or Phnom Kulen is declared as a National Park. It is an isolated mountain massif located in Svay Leu District and some 48km from Siem Reap. Its highest point is 487 meters. Phnom Kulen has a symbolic importance and it is venerated by Cambodians as the birthplace of the ancient Khmer Empire.

Visit the pagoda with a large reclining Buddha where the Buddha's head is on the right side, which is a rarity. This is a good stop for a quick prayer. Enjoy your lunch by the river side and refresh yourselves in the waterfalls.

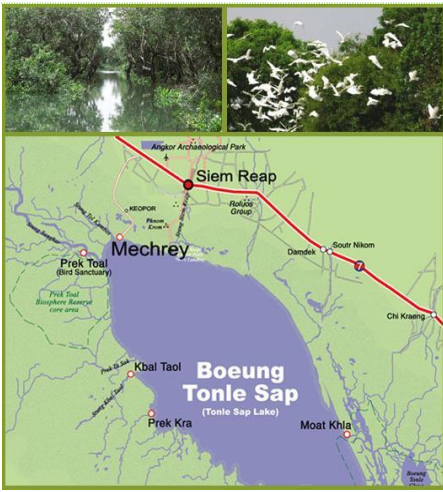
Half Day Shopping and Handicraft (Half day)

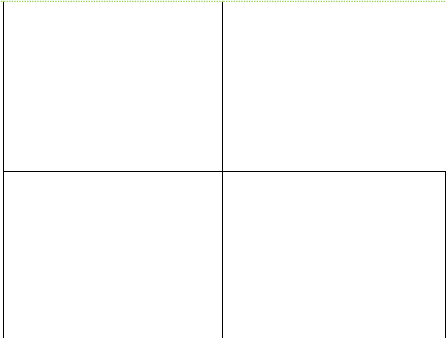


Mechrey Natural Community Base Tourism (Half day)

Kompong Phluk Tour – (Half Day)

This morning, we will pick up you from hotel by private coach. You travel the rest of the way by boat down the Kompong Phluk river and into the main village. The village is home to approx 3000 predominately Khmer fishing people, where, depending on the time of year, you will either sail on through the main street of the village (when the water is high the roads become a river) or walk along it in the low water level season. Whichever way, its a great opportunity to see how the rural fishing villages work/live and go about there daily tasks. There are a few schools, large bob-ha pergola and many stilted homes towering some 9 meters high to adapt to the changing water levels.

Cultural Immersion Program – (Full day)

Discover the cultural side of Cambodia on a multi-faceted tour that allows you to get a full experience as you create your own shadow puppet, learn traditional dances, and play an instrument. Top all this excitement off with an authentic lunch and tales of local folklore. Begin you tour with a leather working class where you learn to craft your own puppet. A master leather carver assists you as you trace your design onto the material and then carve it out; leaving behind a fascinating creature that you attach a stick to, completing the puppet effect. Your next appointment is with dancers that teach you to do a classic Cambodian dance called *Aspara* for women or the *Giant* dance for men. At the same venue, the instrumental band takes you under their wing to show you an introductory lesson on the different musical instruments used in Cambodia.
