Day 1 Kuala Lumpur-Tashkent (Wednesday - Thursday)

03:20 Arrival to Tashkent by HY 552 Uzbekistan Airways.

Meeting at “ISLAM KARIMOV” International airport by **UZBEK MODELS WITH FLOWERS** your guide outside of arrival hall.

04:20 Transfer to the hotel and check- in. Early check in time is **06:00**.

Free time for rest.

11:00 Meeting at hotel lobby and start full day City Tashkent tour with a professional Guide and all Entrance Tickets included:

- Ensemble of Hazret Imam
(Here you can see the oldest manuscript of Uzbekistan and famous Muslim heritage –Holy Koran Mushaf of Othman which also has the certificate of authenticity from UNESCO.)
- Kukeldash Madrasah
(Located on the square Chorsu, was built in the 16th century during the reign of the Sheibankhan dynasty. Now it is a college, where the basics of Islam are taught.)
- Chorsu Bazaar
(The wholesale oriental bazaar where you can bargain till 50% of any product.)

Tashkent Metro , Amir Timur Square, Monument of Courage, Square “Nation’s Friendship” ,

Lunch at restaurant.

Continue of city tour Independence Square, Repressions Park.

20.00 Dinner at Uzbek restaurant.

21:30 Transfer to hotel.

Overnight in Tashkent city.

Day 2. Tashkent-Bukhara (Friday)

08.00 – 10.00 Breakfast at hotel.

Take a train to Bukhara at 07.00 Arrival at 11.40 Lunch-box in train.

Transfer to old city.

Starting city tour of Bukhara.

City tour in old city.

- Ismoil Somoniy Mausoleum

(This world-famous architectural masterpiece was built at the close of the ninth century. The mausoleum was erected as a family crypt immediately after the death of Ismail Samani’s father.)

- Chashma Ayub Mausoleum

(Chashma-Ayub well, translated as Saint Job’s Source. A legend has it that the Bible prophet Job, having visited this land, decided to help the people who suffered from water shortage in the desert. He struck the ground with his stick, making a source of crystal clear water sprang at that place.)

- Bolo Khouz Complex

(Bolo-Khouz Complex is the only preserved monument on the Registan Square. It is located on the opposite site of Ark - the Emir’s fortress. The complex consists of the reservoir, Friday mosque and minaret. Lunch check in to hotel.)

- Ark Fortress

(Ark-Citadel is a residence of Bukhara khans. According to the last excavations, it was determined the citadel was on this place from 4 century BC. For many years of building and destruction, 20 meters height artificial hill was formed; its upper layers were built over in the time of last Bukharin emirs.)

Dinner at Uzbek Restaurant

Overnight in Bukhara city.

Day 3 Bukhara (Saturday)

07:00-09:00 Breakfast at hotel.

Continue of the tour :

Lyabi Khaus Ensemble - Architectural ensemble Lyabi-Khauz is formed with three large monumental buildings: Kukeldash Madrasah in the north, Khanaka and Nodir Divan-begi in the west and in the east. From the south the square was closed with Trade Street. The center of old Bukhara large ensemble became a reservoir.

Trading domes of Bukhara – the famous oriental wholesale bazaars - domes stretching in procession from Lyabi-Khauz to the Miri-Arab madrasah.

Lunch. After lunch outside of Bukhara

Mausoleum of Bahovuddin Naqshbandiy - Imamu Tarikatti Shakh Mukhammad Bahau-d Din An Nakshbandi al-Uvaysi al Bukhari (the founder of "nakshbandiya" branch).

You will visit graves of this people and talk with their followers, listen to mystic stories about them.

Next to the graves of seven sufi of Bukhara stay people who look after the graves. Those are followers of sufis. They talk about life of sufis, about their activities and talk stories about them.

Grave of Bibi Orifa – mother of Bahovuddin Naqshbandiy. Transfer back to hotel

Continue tour of the last emir's summer residence Sitoraoa Mokhi Hosa, Chor- Bakr Necropolis.

20:00 Dinner at Uzbek Restaurant

Overnight in Bukhara city.

Day 4. Bukhara – Samarkand (Sunday)

Early breakfast in the hotel.

8:00 Transfer to Samarkand. (200km/3/4 hrs)

12:30 Arrival in Samarkand.

13:00 Lunch at Uzbek restaurant

Visit **Imam Ismail Al-Bukhari Memorial Complex**.

(Highly respected scientist of the Islamic world, mukhaddis (collector of sayings of prophet Mohammed and stories about him) Imam Ismail Al-Bukhari was born in Bukhara in 810 and died in 870 in the village of Khartang and was buried at the same place (Chelak district of the present Samarkand province located 30 km from Samarkand). Since then the burial place has been one of the most sacred sites of worship for Muslims.)

20:00 Dinner at Uzbek Restaurant

Overnight in Samarqand city.

Day 5. Samarkand-Tashkent (Monday)

08:00 Early breakfast in the hotel.

09:00 Visit:

Saint Daniel Mazar - The only place in Central Asia where Muslim, Jewish, Christian people together consider as sacred place in their religion.

The mausoleum of **Gur Emir**, a burial place of Amir Temur and other princess of his family.

Registan Square, the heart of Samarkand consisting of Madrassa of Ulugbek, Madrassa Sher Dor and Tillya-Kori Madrassah. (From outside for entry extra)

Bibi Khanum Mosque, once the biggest mosque in Central Asia, it was erected by order of Tamerlane after his victorious Indian campaign in 1399. (From outside for entry extra)

Shakhi Zinda (Alive King) Necropolis, a site of pilgrimage visited since the 11th century and marked by holiness. The mausoleum of Qusam Ibn Abbas the cousin of Prophet Muhammads (s.a.v) also in this Necropolis. It consists of about 20 mausoleums of different centuries built between 11th – 19th centuries. Interesting magic and historical legends will be told by your guide.

13:00 Lunch.

Visit: Shopping at famous oriental Siyob bazaar – The biggest dry fruit market in Central Asia. This market provides all Central Asian and Former Soviet Union countries with dry fruits. You can find here more than 1000 types of dry fruits.

Transfer to Railway station.

Take a high-speed train "Afrosiyob" to Tashkent at 17:00 – 19:00 (300km/2hrs)

Arrival to Tashkent and transfer to restaurant for Dinner. Check in.

Overnight in Tashkent city.

Day 6. Tashkent-Charvak – Chimgan- Tashkent (Tuesday)

07.00-09.00 Enjoy buffet breakfast at your hotel's coffee shop.

09.00 Chimgan Mountains and Charvak Lake

(Chimgan is the most popular ski resort the part of Chatkal range of western Tian-Shan.)

11.30. Ride on chairlift.

14.00. Lunch in Garden and **Have a Picnic** with preparing Barbeque. After Lunch the group do gardening: Pick up different kind of tasteful fruits with help of locals and have a chance to taste them in a place. As well, doing selfie to make memorize of unforgettable moments.

Drive to Charwak Lake.

(Lake Charvak is a popular resort in Tashkent region and thousands of holiday makers from all over Uzbekistan and neighbor countries visit the reservoir.

Enjoy free time at Beautiful Charwak Lake with numerous relaxing activities, for instance, Riding Horse, Paragliding, sailing with Motor Boat and Jet Ski.)

17.00. Return to the Hotel.

20.30 Dinner at Uzbek Restaurant with belly dance show performance.

Overnight in Tashkent City.

Day 7. Tashkent-Kuala Lumpur (Wednesday)

05:00 Morning transfer to International Airport of Tashkent

Flight to Kuala Lumpur at 07.55 by HY Uzbekistan Airways.
