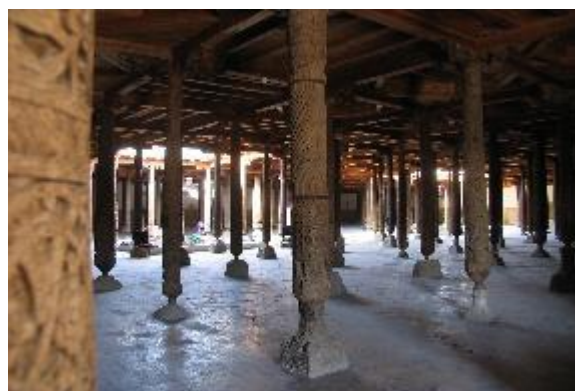


## 8 Days Uzbekistan – Turkmenistan – Kazakhstan

Valid till 31 Dec 2018

### Day 1, Thu: Tashkent – Urgench – Khiva (domestic flight)

Arrival to Tashkent international airport. Escort guide will meet you with “Your company logo” signboard at airport meeting area and transfer to domestic airport. Registration and flight for Urgench by first morning flight. Upon arrival transfer and check in to the hotel. Time for rest. Afternoon city tour in Khiva: Ichan-Qala is the inner city in Khiva rounded with strong walls. Centuries old sound buildings, palaces, mosques, Madrasahs, Mausoleums, Minarets, Caravan-Sarais and Bathhouses transformed Ichan-Qala into unique city-monument. Ichan - Qala consists of over 400 traditional dwelling houses and about 60 architectural monuments. At the end of excursion returning back to the hotel. Overnight is at the hotel.



### Day 2, Fri: Khiva – Kunya Urgench (Turkmenistan) – Ashgabat (domestic flight)

Breakfast is at the hotel. Transfer to Shavat border check point between Uzbekistan and Turkmenistan (60 km), crossing the border, stamp the visas, meet with your Turkmen guide and continue the drive to Kunya Urgench. City tour in Kunya Urgench owes its Unesco world heritage status to the fact that it was an important Silk Road hub on the Oxus River, and capital of the Khorezm Empire (12th c AD), until its destruction by the armies of Dzhengis Khan. Transfer to Dashouz, evening flight to Ashgabat. Arrival and check in to the hotel.



### Day 3, Sat: Ashgabat

Breakfast is at the hotel. City tour in Ashgabat: National Museum - Opened in 1998, the museum's 9 history halls houses the Turkmenistan's major collection of artifacts discovered at various excavation sites in Turkmenistan. Nissa Historical Park - located on a natural high platform at the foothills of the Kopetdag Mountains, Nissa owes its importance to the early Parthian rulers who took over control of the area in III c. BC. Proof of Hellenistic architecture

and Zoroastrian worship are clearly visible at the site, while the magnificent collection of ivory rythons found here, can be admired at the National Museum in Ashgabat. Overnight is at the hotel.



**Day 4, Sun: Ashgabat – Almaty (flight 20:00-23:50, Turkmen Airlines)**

Breakfast is at the hotel. City tour in Ashgabat: Weekend bazaar (Tolkuchka) - The original bazaar called as Tolkuchka Bazaar (or Push Market) and was one of the biggest bazaars in Central Asia. Now it has been slightly relocated and renamed ton Altyn Asyr Gundogar Bazaar. Turkmenbashi Spiritual Mosque and Mausoleum in Kipchak - the Ruhy Mosque (literally: spiritual mosque) at Kipchak was built between 2002 and 2004, and is one of the five largest mosques in the world (capacity of 20,000 people). Transfer to airport, flight for Almaty. Upon arrival Almaty transfer and overnight is at the hotel.



**Day 5, Mon: Almaty**

The tour starts with sightseeing in the central part of Almaty. You will know more about history and development of the southern capital of Kazakhstan and see its major attractions: Central State Museum, Palace of President, Republic Square and Monument of Independence, Abai Opera and Ballet Theatre, Astana Square, Almaty Railway Station, Central Mosque, Green Bazaar, Abai Square and Palace of Republic. You will also visit the Memorial of Glory and Eternal Flame, dedicated to the memory of the fighters who died for freedom and independence of the country. In the evening transfer to the hotel.



**Day 6, Tue: Almaty – Tashkent (flight 13:50-14:20, Uzbek airways)**

Breakfast is at the hotel. Transfer to Almaty airport, flight to Tashkent (13:50-14:20). Upon arrival to Tashkent transfer to your hotel, check in and time for rest. Evening exploring city center of Tashkent: Broadway - walking street between independence square and Amir Timur square. Amir Timur square – one of the central squares of Tashkent, erected on behalf of national hero – Amir Timur. The square symbolizes sovereignty and power of Uzbek nation. Overnight is at the hotel.



**Day 7, Wed: Tashkent – Samarkand – Tashkent (Bullet train)**

After the breakfast, you will be transferred to railway station of Tashkent. Board the train and transfer for Samarkand by fast train. Upon arrival transfer to your hotel, check in and time for rest. Afterwards tour of Samarkand: drive outside of the city to visit Al Bukhary memorial complex (12 km away of the city). Registan square – the complex of three historical building: Madrasah Ulugbek (15th c.), Madrasah Sher-dor (17th c.), Madrasah Tilla-Kori (17th c.) – the visiting card and the main attraction spot of Samarkand. Mausoleum Guri Emir - Tamerlane’s tomb (14-15th c.) Transfer to Samarkand railway station and departure for fast train to Tashkent. Upon arrival transfer to your hotel. Overnight is at the hotel.



**Day 8, Thu: Tashkent – Kuala Lumpur**

Breakfast is at the hotel. Half-day tour in Tashkent: Old city – old part of Tashkent city, the area, which preserves the traditional Uzbek style: Kukaldash Madrasah (16<sup>th</sup>.c) and Hast Imam complex – the Islamic heart of the country. Moreover, Madrasah exhibits one of the Islamic relics - the Othman Quran, the world’s oldest Quran copy dating back to 8<sup>th</sup> c. Quran belonged to Othman Ibn Affan, the Third Caliph (of the four righteous Caliphs who succeeded the prophet Muhammad). Othman was killed by non-muslims in 8<sup>th</sup> century. His blood spread over the Quran. You still can see blood drops on Quran’s pages. After the excursion transfer to Tashkent airport, registration and flight for Singapore.
