Day 01	Tashkent Almaty		Flight to Tashkent. Flight to Almaty. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel.		Hotel
Day 02	Almaty		Sightseeing of Almaty city, visiting the Panfilov park and Zenkov Cathedral , one of the world's tallest all wood buildings. Here you will visit the unique national museum of Kazak Musical Instruments. After lunch you will visit the Central State Museum and ascend the Kok-Tube Mountain by cable railway. At the end of the gorge there is a ski resort Chimbulak, situated at an altitude of 2.200 m above sea level. It is one of Central Asia's top skiing spots. Later return to your hotel. Day 05	Karakol – Issyk-Kul	auto	After breakfast short sightseeing tour of Karakol, visit Russian Orthodox Church , Dungan Mosque and Przewalsky Museum. Drive to Issyk-Kul. Lunch at eco-farm Reina-Kench (organic food) Visit an open air museum of petroglyphs dated to 3rd century AD to 14th century AD. 1 hour boat tour on the lake to contemplate the scenery from the water surface. Day 06	Issyk-kul – Bishkek	auto	Drive to Bishkek via Burana Tower, the remain of Karakhanid minaret. Nearby is a unique collection of Turkish stone grave makers. Then continue to nearby village for a special lunch prepared and served according to Kyrgyz tradition, including typical Kyrgyz national dishes. Enjoy the Kyrgyz national horse games. Day 07	Bishkek – Tashkent	Auto,	Half day Sightseeing of Bishkek city, visiting the most interesting sights: Victory square, Main Russian Orthodox Church , Kyrgyz philharmonic society, famous oriental Osh market, Ala-Too square. Day 08	Tashkent	auto	Sightseeing of Tashkent: Sacred Heart Parish Church of Tashkent - the largest Catholic Church in Central Asia (1912-1917-1993). Here, you can enjoy organ concert and unique singing. The only Evangelical – Lutheran Church in Central Asia was designed by famous Russian architect A. Benua and was contracted between 1895-1899. Svyato-Uspenskiy Cathedral , whose original building was constructed in 1871 on the territory of military hospital, is dedicated to St. Pomteleymon. During 1945 -1950 the church was enlarged under the direction of archbishop Ermogen and became Svyato Uspensky Cathedral of Tashkent. Independence Square, Amir Temur Monument and Square, Alisher Navoi Theater, subway. Overnight in Tashkent	B: Hotel L: Restaurant D: Restaurant	Hotel
Day 09	Tashkent - Bukhara	Auto. train	Transfer to the rail way station to take express train Afrosiab to Bukhara. Arrival. Sightseeing tour in Bukhara: Mausoleum of Samanid Dynasty, local bazaar, Ark Citadel, Trading domes, Lyabi-Khauz Ensemble. After lunch visit Summer Residence of Bukhara’s last Emir, then proceed with sightseeing of the churches: the Church of Archangel Michael representing a converted building of the railway station dating back to 1904; the new St. Andrew the Apostle Church , registered with the state in 2002 but constructed in 2005.
