City tour around Tashkent, visit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Khazrat Imam Complex, consisting of Kaffal Shashi mausoleum, Barak Khan Madrasah, Tillya Sheikh Mosque, Museum with 7th century Koran of Caliph Othman,</li> <li>– Kukeldash Madrasah and Djuma Mosque from outside; Chorsu Bazaar,</li> <li>– Museum of Applied Arts, and Tashkent Metro;</li> <li>– The Independence Square and Memorial of Victory,</li> <li>– Amir Temur Square and Pedestrian Street with Artist Alley,</li> </ul> <p>Dinner at local restaurant. <b>DAY 2.</b>  <b>TASHKENT BUKHARA</b>	<p>Breakfast at hotel.</p> <p>06.30-06.45 Transfer to Railway Station for the train to Bukhara / 07.30-11.15 /</p> <p>Start tour Bukhara is known as one of the Central Asia’s most ancient living city:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Lyabi Khauz Complex – the heart of the city consisting of Kukeldash madrasah; Nadir Devan Begi Madrasah and Khanaka;</li> <li>– Magoki Attor Mosque one of the oldest Mosques in Central Asia,</li> <li>– Toki Sarrafon – cupola of moneychangers, Toki Telpak Furushon – cupola of the hat sellers, Toki Zargaron – cupola of jewelers, Abdulla khan Tim – a center of silk trade,</li> <li>– Abdul Aziz Khan Madrasah and Ulugbek Madrasah,</li> <li>– Kalon complex consisting of Mosque, Minaret; and Mir Arab Madrasah;</li> </ul> <p>Dinner at local restaurant. <b>DAY 3.</b>  <b>BUKHARA</b>	<p>After breakfast Continue tour of Bukhara by visiting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Citadel Ark, the palace of the rulers of Bukhara, Bolo Khauz Mosque with beautiful ayvan in traditional Bukharian style.</li> <li>– Chashma Ayub Mausoleum – The tomb of Prophet Job.</li> <li>– The “pearl of the east” The Samanid mausoleum,</li> <li>– Summer Palace of Last Rulers; and Bahautdin Nakshband Complex;</li> </ul> <p>Dinner at local restaurant. En route visit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Gizjduvan Ceramics Workshop</li> </ul> <p>Upon arrival transfer to hotel, check in. Start tour in the capital of the Great Empire of Tamerlane, the place that attracted Alexander the Great, Marco Polo, and thousand visitors from the world.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Gur-Emir mausoleum, the family burial of Timurids; Ruhabad mausoleum from outside;</li> <li>– Registan Square consisting of Ulugbek, Sherdord and Tilla Kari Madrasah, some free time.</li> </ul> <p>Dinner at local restaurant. <b>DAY 5.</b>  <b>SAMARKAND SHAKHRISABZ</b>	<p>Breakfast at hotel. Depart to Shakhrisabz, 140km 3hrs, the birthplace of Tamerlane, through the pasturelands of Khissar Range of Pamir Mountains. Arrive and start tour by visiting the magnificent architectural monuments of the Timurids:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Remains of Ak-Saray palace of Tamerlane;</li> <li>– Mausoleum of Djehangir; and Khazrat Imam Mosque;</li> <li>– Mausoleum of Sheik Shamsiddin Kulal; and Gumbazi Saidon mausoleum;</li> <li>– Kok Gumbaz Mosque and Chorsu trade dome.</li> </ul> <p>Depart back to Samarkand, 140km 3hrs.
