DAY 1. _____	Arrival to Tashkent airport with flight . Upon arrival customs and immigration clearance. AIRPORT ASSISTANCE ARRANGED. Meet your guide / driver outside of arrival hall and transfer to hotel, check in. Overnight in Tashkent.
DAY 2. _____	Breakfast at hotel. Tashkent – The Capital of Independent Uzbekistan, the cosmopolitan city in the heart of Central Asia, the crossroad of cultures and the Great Silk Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Khazrat Imam Complex consisting of Museum of Islamic Calligraphy, Barak Khan Madrasah, Kaffal Shashi Mausoleum; Tillya Sheikh Mosque; – Chorsu Bazaar and Kukeldash and Djuma Mosque from outside; – Museum of Applied Arts; – Amir Temur Square and and Tashkent Metro; Overnight in Tashkent.
DAY 3. _____	Breakfast at hotel. Depart to Samarkand by road, 320km 5hrs. Upon arrival Transfer for check in to hotel. Samarkand – Eden of the East praised by Medieval poets and historians, Capital of Tamerlane Empire, city that attracted Alexander the Great, Genghis Khan, and others. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Gur Emir Mausoleum; and Ruhabad Mausoleum from outside; – Registan Square, consisting of 3 Madrasah: Ulugbek, Sherdor, and Tillya Kari Madrasah; – Shakhi Zinda Necropolis; and Silk Paper Workshop Overnight in Samarkand.
DAY 4. MON 19 march 2018	Breakfast at hotel. Continue tour of Old Samarkand: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Bibi-Khanum Mosque, and Colorful Siyab Bazaar – Museum of Ulugbek Observatory; and Saint Daniel Mausoleum; – Museum of Ancient Afrosiab, with frescos from 7th c – Mausoleum of Imam Al Bukhari Overnight at hotel.

DAY 5. SAMARKAND BUKHARA	Breakfast at hotel. Depart to Bukhara by road, 280km 4-5hrs. Arrival to city and check in to hotel. Tour in the old center of Tajik culture, where locals speak Tajik language the dialect of Farsi. Explore one of the gems of Islamic architecture, the center of Mediaeval Islamic Education. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Lyabi Khauz Complex consisting of Nadir Devan Begi Madrasah and Khanaka; Kukeldash Madrasah; Sarrofon Trade Dome; and Nugay Caravanserai; – Abdul Aziz Khan Madrasah and Ulugbek Madrasah; – Trade Domes of Silk Road Bazaar, Magoki Attor Mosque, – Kalon Complex consisting of Kalon Minaret, Kalon Mosque, and Mir Arab Madrasah, Overnight in Bukhara.
DAY 6. BUKHARA NAVRUZ CELEBRATION	Breakfast at hotel. Today it is a National Holiday, and people are visiting each other and have a Festive feeling. Continue tour by visiting highlights of architectural heritage. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Ark Citadel, Bolo Khauz Mosque, – Ismail Samani Mausoleum, Chashma Ayub Mausoleum; – Chor Bakr Necropolis; and Chor Minor Madrasah; – Summer Palace of Last Rulers of Bukhara Sitorai Mokhi Khosa, – Complex of Bahautdin Nakshband; Gala Dinner at Traditional house with Pilaaf Cooking class, here you try Navruz special meals. Folklore Performance during the dinner. Overnight in Bukhara.
DAY 7. BUKHARA TASHKENT SINGAPORE	Breakfast at hotel. Check out from hotel and transfer airport for the flight to Tashkent. Upon arrival continue tour of Tashkent: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – The Independence Square and Memorial of Victory, – Memorial of Victims, TV Tower from outside, – Minor Mosque and Monument of Courage; – Abulkasim Madrasah – center of Handicrafts; National Park with Statue of Alisher Navoi; 18.00 Transfer to Airport for International flight
