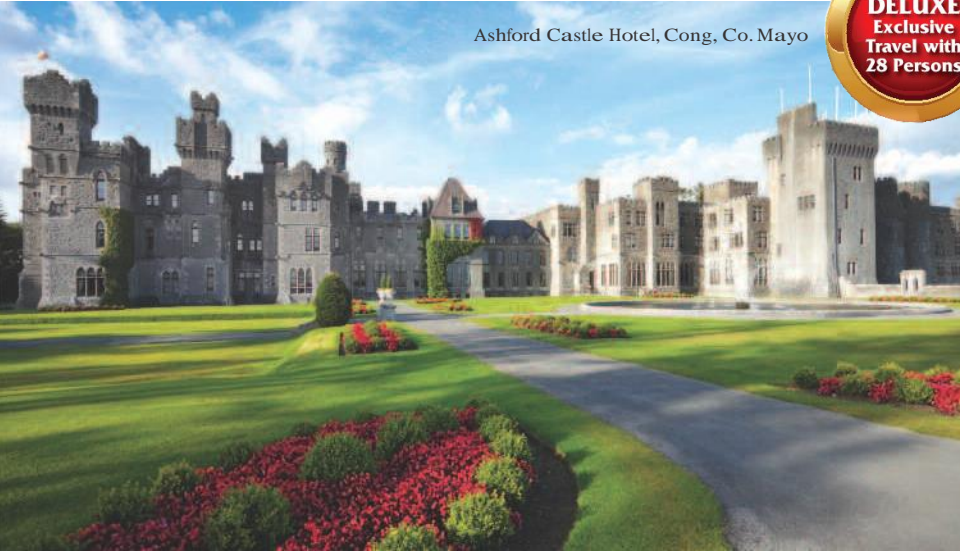

Day 1: Dublin & Book of Kells

Start at your Dublin hotel at 2:00 pm to see Dublin's highlights. Take a walk through Trinity College to view the priceless 8th century Book of Kells. In the evening enjoy a welcome drink.

Day 2: National Stud & Farmhouse Lunch

Travel to Kildare to visit the Irish National Stud and walk through the charming Gardens. Lunch at a farmhouse and chat about country living. Drive south to Ballycotton and your delightful country house overlooking the sea. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Cork & Blarney Castle

Drive into the city of Cork for a gentle walking tour around the central areas with a local guide. Then head to Blarney Castle where you may climb to the top to kiss the famous stone or shop at the Blarney Woollen Mills. Travel to Killarney and take a jaunting car ride to admire the scenery. (B, D)

Day 4: Ring of Kerry & Killeen House

Set out on the Ring of Kerry drive where every bend in the road reveals breathtaking views. Visit the Skellig Experience, which explains the rocky islands offshore. Watch trained dogs herding sheep and also shearing. Dine at the award-winning Killeen House Restaurant. (B, D)

Day 5: Cliffs of Moher & Dromoland

Visit the Cliffs of Moher, majestic walls of rock, which extend eight km along the coast. Journey through part of the Burren Country to your lovely castle hotel where you will have an opportunity to relax in the wonderful setting. (B, D)

Day 6: Gaelic Ireland & Ashford Castle

Travel to Galway for a walking tour to see medieval walls and ancient streets. Visit Cnoc Suain, a restored 17th century hill-village. Continue north to Cong to Ashford Castle Hotel. (B, D)

Day 7: Connemara & Kylemore Abbey

Drive through the stunning scenery of Connemara and visit Kylemore Abbey. Tour the rooms of the elegant mansion and walk along the lake shore. Stop in Clifden for a look around and drive to historic Ballynahinch Castle for a tour of the property before savouring an early dinner. (B, D)

Day 8: Kilbeggan & Dublin Restaurant

Drive through the centre of Ireland and visit Kilbeggan Distillery to see whiskey making and sample an Irish coffee. Drive to Dublin and head to O'Connell's Restaurant for dinner. (B, D)

Day 9: Russborough House & City Tour

Take a short ride through the Wicklow Mountains for a guided tour around stately Russborough House, noted for its art and photography collections. In the afternoon use your open-top bus tour voucher for further city sightseeing and visit Guinness Storehouse or General Post Office. (B)

Day 10: It's Time to Head Home

Your tour ends after breakfast in your hotel. (B)
