**Day 1: Dublin Arrival & Dalkey Village**  
Your trip starts at 2:00 pm at your Dublin hotel. Take a walking tour of Dalkey Village and visit Dalkey Castle. In the evening meet your tour director over a welcome drink and dine independently.

**Day 2: Dublin Tour & Abbey Tavern**  
Take a guided tour of central Dublin. Walk through Trinity College's campus to view the Book of Kells. In the afternoon use your open-top bus tour voucher and visit Guinness or General Post Office. Enjoy Abbey Tavern's dinner and show. (B, D)

**Day 3: Strokestown Park House & Galway**  
Visit Strokestown Park House to tour the 18th century mansion and the Famine Museum, which explains the 1840's Great Irish Famine. Take a walking tour of Galway's medieval streets. (B, D)

**Day 4: Lough Corrib Cruise & Connemara**  
Enjoy scenery on a cruise on Lough Corrib and sip an Irish coffee. Drive through Connemara to admire hills, lakes and peat bogs. Tour Kylemore Abbey and enjoy a casual lunch. (B, L)

**Day 5: Cliffs of Moher & Ennis**  
At Rathbaun Farm see traditional farm animals and watch trained dogs herd sheep. View the Cliffs of Moher, an impressive wall of rock and continue to Ennis for a walking tour around this charming town and visit Ennis Friary. (B, D)

**Day 6: Flying Boat Museum & Killarney**  
Cross the River Shannon by ferry and visit the Foynes Flying Boat Museum, which recalls the early days of air travel. Head to Killarney and dine at Killeen House Restaurant, renowned for excellent food. (B, D)

**Day 7: Ring of Kerry & Jaunting Car**  
Drive to Kenmare and join the Ring of Kerry route at Moll's Gap for great views. Shop and have some lunch at the Gap of Dunloe Industries. Take a

traditional horse-drawn jaunting car ride through the Gap of Dunloe to admire scenery. (B, D)

**Day 8: Bantry House & Cork Coastline**  
Today travel into County Cork to visit Bantry House, a charming, mansion dating to the 1760's. Drive along the coast to Kinsale and join a local guide to visit the huge Charles Fort and take a walking tour through the town. (B, D)

**Day 9: Cork Harbour Cruise & Blarney**  
Take a short walking tour through Cork and then a cruise of Cork Harbour to view places associated with RMS Titanic. Drive to Blarney Castle to kiss the famous stone, walk through the grounds or shop at the Blarney Woollen Mills. (B, D)

**Day 10: Rock of Cashel & Dunboyne**  
Visit the stately Rock of Cashel, a limestone outcrop with 12th century church ruins. Drive to your luxurious castle hotel, located on the outskirts of Dublin. Enjoy a farewell dinner with your travel companions. (B, D)
