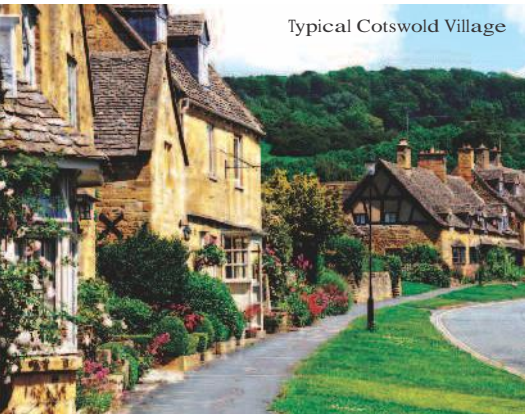

**Day 1: London Arrival & Tour**

Take a guided tour around St Andrews, famous for golfing. Also visit the romantic ruins of St Andrews Cathedral before driving north through wonderful Highland scenery to Inverness. (B, D)

**Day 7: Highlands & Loch Lomond**  
Travel south through more magnificent Highland peaks and past Loch Ness. Take a scenic cruise on Loch Lomond and tour Glasgow. (B, D)

**Day 8: Titanic Belfast & Dublin**  
Drive south to Cairnryan and take a ferry to Ireland. Visit Titanic Belfast to learn about the famous liner. Stop at the Glyde Inn for dinner and music on the way to Dublin. (B, D)



**Day 9: Dublin Tour & Kilmainham Gaol**  
Tour Dublin city centre to see many attractions and visit the historic Kilmainham Gaol. Take an open-top bus tour in the afternoon and evening is at leisure. (B)

**Day 10: Blarney & Killarney**  
Pass the Rock of Cashel on the way to visit Blarney Castle to kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Drive to your hotel in Killarney. (B, D)

**Day 11: Jaunting Car & Dingle Cruise**  
See Killarney by jaunting car before driving out along the scenic Dingle Peninsula and taking a cruise. Dine at Kate Kearney's Cottage. (B, D)

**Day 12: Foynes & Cliffs of Moher**  
Visit the Foynes Flying Boat Museum to learn about the early days of flight. View the magnificent Cliffs of Moher and take a walking tour of Galway. (B, D)

**Day 13: Farm Tea & Fitzpatrick Castle**  
Sample tea and scones at Rathbaun Farm. Drive to Dublin and visit Dalkey Castle. Enjoy a special farewell dinner with your fellow travellers. (B, D)
