

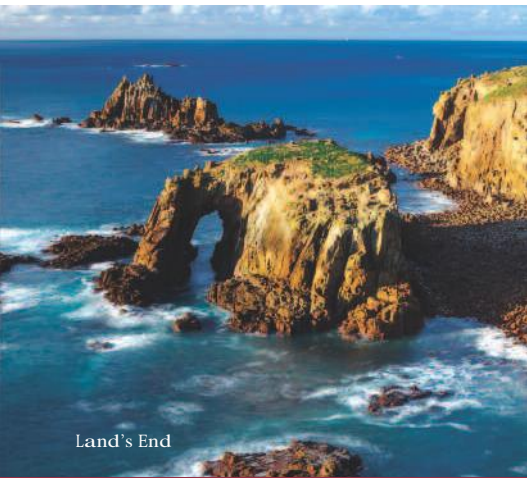

Day 4: Cornwall & Land's End
View the majestic outline of St Michael's Mount. Continue to Land's End, Britain's most westerly point. Visit the Minack Theatre, an open-air arena. (B, D)

Day 5: Roman Baths & Cardiff Walk
Visit the Roman Baths and Pump Room. Drive to Cardiff for a brief walking tour. Head to a Welsh evening for dinner and great Welsh music. (B, D)

Day 6: Hay-on-Wye & Shrewsbury
Drive through the Brecon Beacons National Park to Hay-on-Wye. In Shrewsbury take a walking tour with the town crier. (B, D)

Day 7: North Wales & Chester
Watch trained dogs herding sheep and walk the streets of medieval Conwy. In Chester another walking tour will reveal black-and-white buildings and Roman walls. (B, D)

Travel through the glorious Lake District and stop in Grasmere. Stop at the Old Blacksmith's Shop in Gretna Green and in Edinburgh experience a Scottish evening with a fun show. (B, D)

Day 9: Edinburgh Castle & City Tour
Explore central Edinburgh and see the Royal Mile and tour Edinburgh Castle to view the Crown Jewels of Scotland. The afternoon is free. (B)

Day 10: Excursion to St Andrews
Travel to St Andrews for a panoramic drive and visit the ruins of St Andrews Cathedral. Spend some free time to browse around the town. (B)
