

Day 1: Dublin & Dalkey Village
Your Irish trip starts at 2:00 pm at your Dublin hotel. Take a gentle walking tour through Dalkey Village and visit the imposing Dalkey Castle. Meet your tour director over a welcome drink to discuss your trip and enjoy dinner in your hotel. (D)

Day 2: Dublin Tour & Taylor's Three Rock Pub
Tour central Dublin to see the main attractions and visit St. Patrick's Cathedral, which dates from 1220-1259. In the afternoon explore Dublin by open-top bus, plus a visit to Guinness or the General Post Office. Drive to Taylor's Three Rock Pub for a dinner with music, songs and step-dancing. (B, D)

Day 3: Antrim Coast & Giant's Causeway
Drive to Derry for a walking tour of this historic city. Learn about 20th century history and stroll along the medieval walls. Continue to the Giant's Causeway, enormous hexagonal rocks that have spawned legends about the mythical giant, Finn McCool. Drive along the coast to your hotel in nearby Ballycastle. (B, D)

Day 4: Heritage Farm & Titanic Belfast
Your first stop today is at Sheans Heritage Farm for some Irish hospitality and fun with tea and home-made scones followed by a turf-cutting demonstration. Drive along the scenic coastal route called the Nine Glens of Antrim to Belfast for a city tour and visit Titanic Belfast. Spend some free time to have a look around on your own before dining in your hotel. (B, D)


Day 5: Ferry to Scotland & Pitlochry
Take a ferry to Scotland and drive along the west coast. Tour Pollok House, a grand country house which gives a real flavor of life in the 1930's with lavish family rooms and vast servants' quarters. Continue your drive northwards into the magnificent scenery of the Scottish Highlands to your historic hotel in Pitlochry. (B, D)

Day 6: Whisky Tasting & St Andrews
Tour Blair Athol Distillery to see how whisky is distilled and sample a "wee dram". Continue

The 8-day tour ends after breakfast. The 9-day tour features an independent Edinburgh bus tour and an additional overnight stay. (B)
