Day 1: Dublin Tour & Book of Kells
Start at your Dublin hotel at 2:00 pm and head out to tour central Dublin's highlights. We offer group transfers from airport to hotel between 7:00 am and 12:00 noon. Visit Trinity College's campus to view the 8th century illuminated manuscript of the Book of Kells. Sip a welcome drink and discuss your itinerary with your guide.

Day 2: Glendalough & Waterford
Visit 6th century Glendalough monastic site with its round tower and church ruins, set in a picturesque valley in the Wicklow Mountains. Tour the Dunbrody Famine Ship to learn about emigration before driving to Waterford. After dinner take a brief walking tour around central Waterford and learn about its long history. (B, D)

Day 3: Waterford Crystal & Blarney Castle
Watch glass blowing and cutting at the House of Waterford Crystal. Drive along the south coast to Cobh for a walking tour. Climb the steps of Blarney Castle to kiss the "Stone of Eloquence" and shop at the Blarney Woollen Mills. Drive through the rugged scenery to Killarney and relax before dinner. (B, D)

Day 4: Ring of Kerry & Skellig Experience
Experience the popular Ring of Kerry tour where the road winds between mountains and coast offering scenic views at every turn. Visit the Skellig Experience and enjoy a casual lunch. Continue your drive around the the Ring of Kerry and watch trained dogs herd flocks of sheep. (B, L)

Day 5: Cliffs of Moher & Galway
Travel north from Killarney and take a ferry ride across the River Shannon Estuary. View the awesome Cliffs of Moher rising to heights of 200m above the wild Atlantic swells. Pass through the rounded limestone hills of the Burren and around Galway Bay to Galway for a walking tour in the city centre. (B, D)

Day 6: Yeats' Grave & Derry Walk
Drive north through the pilgrimage town of Knock to Sligo to view the grave of the Nobel Prize-winning poet, W. B. Yeats. Travel around Donegal Bay and through the majestic and rugged scenery of Donegal to Derry. Take a guided walk around the medieval walls, which completely encircle the old part of the city. (B, D)

Day 7: Giant's Causeway & Belfast
Visit the Giant's Causeway, enormous hexagonal columns formed by volcanic activity over 60 million years ago. Drive to Belfast for a visit to Titanic Belfast. The state-of-the-art attraction is devoted to the development and construction of the ill-fated liner that was built in the nearby docks. Head south and stop for dinner and some fun Irish music before reaching Dublin city and check in to your hotel. (B, D)

Day 8: Back Home or Extra Day in Dublin
Our 8-day tour ends after breakfast. If you are on our 9-day tour, take an open-top bus tour of Dublin city with a visit to Guinness or General Post Office. (B)
