

Day 1: Dublin Tour & Book of Kells Start at your Dublin hotel at 2:00 pm to see Dublin's highlights with Georgian squares, statue-lined streets and public buildings. Walk through Trinity College's campus and view the priceless Book of Kells. Join your fellow guests for a welcome drink and dine independently. (See page 2 for transfer information.)

Day 2: Clonmacnoise & Galway Travel to Clonmacnoise, a monastic settlement founded by St. Ciaran in 545 AD on the banks of the River Shannon. View round towers, elaborate Celtic crosses and church ruins. Drive to Galway and check into your hotel, located in the city centre. Meet a local guide for a gentle stroll through the city streets before dinner. (B, D)

Day 3: Connemara Cruise & Kylemore Tour Connemara for sweeping views of misty mountains and shimmering lakes. In Leenane take a short cruise of Killary Fjord and savour lunch at a nearby restaurant. Tour Kylemore Abbey, set in elegant grounds beside a peaceful lake, before returning to Galway. (B, L)

Day 4: Cliffs of Moher & Irish Night Drive south through the Burren to watch trained working dogs herd sheep. View the Cliffs of Moher, which rise almost 200m above the pounding Atlantic surf. Travel by ferry across the River Shannon Estuary and on to Killarney. Take a horse-drawn jaunting car ride to admire the beauty of the lakes and head to Jarvey's Irish Night for a lively show with dinner. (B, D)

Day 5: Ring of Kerry & Muckross House Head off on the Ring of Kerry to admire breathtaking vistas. Visit the Skellig Experience, which explains life on the rocky offshore islands and enjoy a casual lunch. Tour Muckross House, set on one of Killarney's lakes, to see elegantly furnished rooms. (B, L)

Day 6: Blarney Castle & Waterford Crystal Drive to Blarney Castle to kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Shop for quality Irish goods at the Blarney Woollen Mills before driving to Dungarvan for a creamy Irish coffee and an informal traditional music session. Tour the House of Waterford Crystal to see demonstrations of glass blowing and cutting. (B, D)

Day 7: Historic Waterford & O'Connell's Restaurant in Dublin This morning join a local guide for a brief walk around historic Waterford. Visit the nearby Medieval Museum, which incorporates a 13th century Choristers' Hall and the 15th century Mayor's Wine Vault. Continue to Dublin and in the evening drive to O'Connell's Restaurant for an elegant farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 8: Depart for Home or Extra Day in Dublin Our 8-day tour ends after breakfast in your Dublin hotel. Those on the 9-day program remain in Dublin to enjoy an open-top bus tour and a visit to Guinness or General Post Office. (B)
