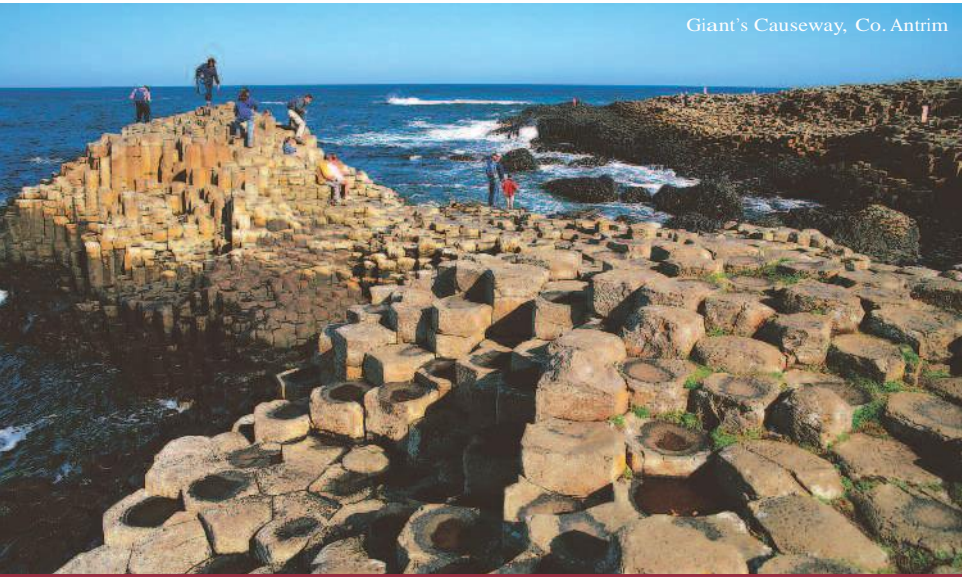

Day 1: Dublin Arrival & Cabra Castle
Start your tour at Cabra Castle Hotel, which is a 90-minute drive from Dublin Airport. Ensure you have a transfer arranged. Relax in the spacious surroundings and enjoy the leisure and sport facilities. Join your tour guide and fellow travellers for a welcome drink and dine in the hotel restaurant. (D)

Day 2: St. Patrick's Country & Belfast Drive
around the Mourne Mountains to Down Cathedral where St. Patrick is buried and learn about his life in the St. Patrick Centre. Drive to Belfast for a city tour with a local guide followed by a visit to the magnificent Titanic Belfast which tells every aspect of this famous liner. (B, D)

Day 3: Glens of Antrim & Giant's Causeway
Drive along the scenic "Nine Glens of Antrim" coastal route and visit Sheans Heritage Farm for tea with scones and a demonstration of turf cutting. Explore the Giant's Causeway, hexagonal columns formed by volcanic activity over 60 million years ago and continue to Derry. (B, D)

Day 4: Inishowen Peninsula & Malin Head
Start your day with a walking tour of Derry. Drive around Ireland's most northerly peninsula for spectacular sea views. Stop for photos at Shrove Lighthouse and sip an Irish coffee in one of Ireland's most northerly pubs. Travel on to Buncrana and learn the story of "Amazing Grace" at the special viewing point. Return to Derry for dinner. (B, D)

Day 5: Donegal Castle & Belleek China
This morning tour Donegal Castle, built in the 15th century by an O'Donnell chieftain. Visit the Belleek Pottery Factory to see how the craftspeople

create the world-famous china. View the grave of W. B. Yeats, the Nobel Prize-winning poet. Drive to your hotel in Westport. (B, D)

Day 6: Westport House & Achill Island
Tour the stately 18th century Westport House to see priceless treasures in an elegant setting. Travel to Achill Island, joined to the mainland by a bridge, to enjoy great scenery and lunch. Return to Westport where the evening is free. (B, L)

Day 7: Galway & Kilbeggan Distillery
Drive to Galway for a walking tour of the city centre. Travel through the centre of Ireland to visit Kilbeggan Distillery, the oldest distillery in the world, to see artisanal whiskey production. In Dublin head to the Merry Ploughboy Pub for traditional entertainment and dinner. (B, D)

Day 8: Head Home or Dublin Sightseeing
The 8-day tour ends at Dublin hotel. The 9-day program features a Dublin tour with visits to Glasnevin Museum and Guinness Storehouse. (B)
