

Day 1: Arrive London & Windsor
Your holiday starts at your Windsor hotel at 2:30 pm when you meet your tour director. Visit Windsor Castle, residence of The Queen and the largest inhabited castle in the world. In the evening meet your tour director for a welcome drink and after dinner take a short walking tour with a local guide. (D)

Day 2: Cotswolds & Stratford-upon-Avon
Head north and through parts of the Cotswolds, stopping in Bampton, where village scenes of "Downton Abbey" were filmed. Drive to Stratford-upon-Avon for a panoramic tour and visit Shakespeare's Birthplace to see an exhibition about his life and the house where he was born. Today it is furnished as it would have been in his day. Travel to York for your overnight stop. (B, D)

Day 3: York Minster & Scottish Evening
Head to central York for a walking tour through narrow streets with medieval houses and visit the stately York Minster. Drive through the Northumberland National Park and stop to view the ruined Jedburgh Abbey. At your historic hotel in Edinburgh dine at a Scottish evening. (B, D)

Day 4: Edinburgh Castle & City Tour
Discover Edinburgh's highlights as you view the elegant Georgian "New Town" and walk along part of the Royal Mile to see the compact medieval city. Tour Edinburgh Castle to see the Crown Jewels of Scotland and the Stone of Destiny. The rest of the day is free. (B)

Day 5: Lake District & Beatles' Liverpool
Stop in the Old Blacksmith's shop at Gretna Green, a popular wedding place near the English border. Drive through the stunning scenery of the Lake District and stop in Grasmere where William Wordsworth lived and worked. Continue to Liverpool and visit The Beatles Story. (B, D)

Day 6: Tintern Abbey & Welsh Evening in Cardiff
Travel south through pleasant Welsh and English countryside and stop in Ludlow. Visit the picturesque ruins of Tintern Abbey, founded in 1131 and dissolved by King Henry VIII. Continue to Cardiff and tour Cardiff Castle. Head to a Welsh evening for dinner and some lively Welsh music and entertainment. (B, D)

Day 7: Roman Baths & Stonehenge
Drive around Cardiff before heading to Bath to visit the Roman Baths and Pump Room, still preserved after two millennia. Drive to Salisbury Plain to view the prehistoric circle of vast mono-liths at Stonehenge. Continue to London. (B)

Day 8: London Tour & Tower
Take a tour around London this morning to see the highlights, including the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, Trafalgar Square, Piccadilly Circus and more. Visit the Tower of London to see the magnificent Crown Jewels and the Beefeaters, guardians of the Tower. (B)

Day 9: Depart for Home or Extend your Stay in London
If you are on a 9-day tour, your program ends after breakfast. Those on a 10-day tour may schedule London sightseeing by open-top bus tour. There are a number of different bus routes to choose from as well as a walking tour and a cruise on the River Thames. (B)
