

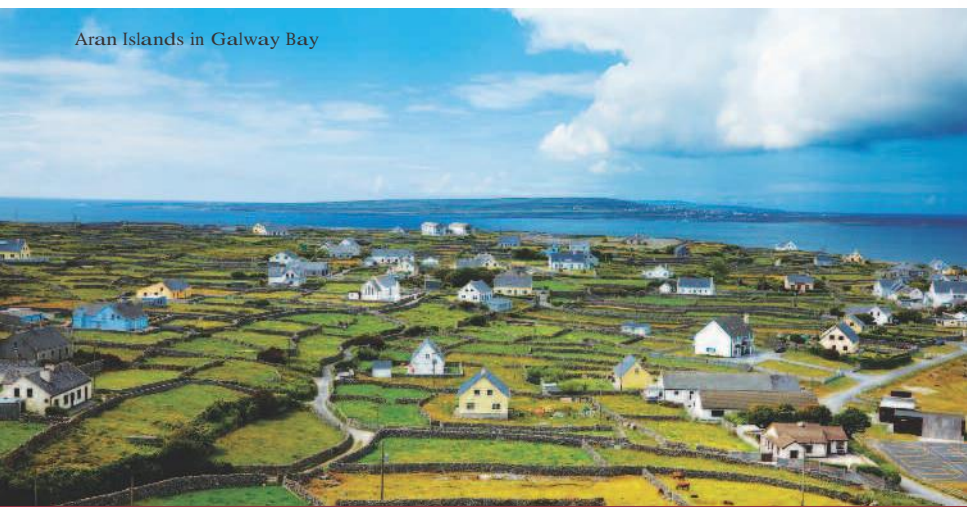

Day 1: Dublin & Malahide Castle

Start at your Dublin hotel at 2:00 pm to tour historic Malahide Castle, home of the Talbot family from 1185 until 1975. The Castle is filled with medieval artifacts and family portraits. Enjoy a welcome get-together drink and dinner to meet your fellow guests. (We offer group transfers from airport to hotel between 7:00 am and 12:00 noon.) (D)

Day 2: National Stud & Ancient Kilkenny

In Kildare visit the Irish National Stud to see magnificent horses and walk through the tranquil gardens. Drive to Jerpoint to meet a farming family for a light lunch, chat about rural living and watch sheepdogs herding. Continue to Kilkenny for a walking tour through the compact centre of this city and dine independently. (B, L)

Day 3: Waterford Crystal & Dunbrody Famine Ship

Drive to Waterford to watch the creation of priceless trophies at the House of Waterford Crystal. Learn about the history of Waterford on a walking tour with a local guide. Explore the Dunbrody Famine Ship, a replica of the vessel used during the 1840's Famine. (B, D)

Day 4: Cobh & Blarney Castle

Drive to Cobh, the last port of call for the Titanic, and visit the Cobh Heritage Centre to learn about emigration from Ireland, especially during the 1840's Famine. Just outside Cork, climb Blarney Castle to gain the "Gift of Eloquence" and continue to Killarney. (B, D)

Day 5: Dingle Peninsula & Jarvey's Irish Night

Discover the glorious Dingle Peninsula with heathery mountains and sandy beaches. Stop at the Blasket Centre and visit the South Pole Inn for an Irish coffee and learn about Tom Crean, an Antarctic explorer. Return to Killarney and head to Jarvey's Irish Night for dinner and a show. (B, D)

Day 6: Cliffs of Moher & Galway Bay

Take a ferry across the River Shannon Estuary to reach the Cliffs of Moher, a wall of rock rising above the churning Atlantic Ocean. Drive through the hills of the Burren and around Galway Bay to Galway for a panoramic city tour. (B, D)

Day 7: Aran Islands & Dun Aengus

Take a short ferry ride from Rossaveal to Inis Mor, the largest of the three Aran Islands. See how the islands maintain many local traditions and visit the huge prehistoric Dun Aengus Fort perched on sheer cliffs. Enjoy a casual lunch on the island. The evening is at leisure for independent dining. (B, L)

Day 8: Clonmacnoise Monastic Site & Taylor's Three Rock Pub

In Clonmacnoise view Celtic crosses and round towers and in Athlone visit Sean's Pub for an Irish coffee. Drive to your hotel a few miles from Dublin city centre and head to Taylor's Three Rock Pub for a traditional dinner with a lively show. (B, D)

Day 9: Depart Dublin or Extra Day

Our 9-day tour ends after breakfast. If you are on our 10-day tour, take an open-top bus tour of Dublin city with a visit to Guinness or G.P.O. (B)
