Itinerary

DAY 1 ARRIVE SARAJEVO

Sarajevo, one of the most historically interesting and varied cities in Europe, where the Western and Eastern Roman Empire split. Sightseeing tour in Sarajevo to see Bascarsija, the Gazi Husrev Mosque, the Old Orthodox Church of St. Archangel's Mikhail and Gabriel, the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Old Jewish Temple and shopping at Bazaar street.

DAY 2 SARAJEVO - (129km) MOSTAR (Bosnia and Herzegovina) - (146km) DUBROVNIK

Sarajevo War Tunnel Museum(include entrance): The "house" museum is exhibiting archival materials including war photographs, military equipment, flags and military uniforms, flotsam and jetsam. It was built on a historic private house whose cellar served as the entrance to Sarajevo Tunnel.

Mostar, a beautiful valley bedded in between high mountains of Herzegovina, known for its famous stone bridge across Neretha river, built by the Ottoman empire.

Dubrovnik, also known as the Pearl of the Adriatic.

DAY 3 DUBROVNIK - (93KM) BUDVA (Montenegro) - (23KM) KOTOR - (91KM) DUBROVNIK

Budva with a panoramic view over St Stefan, an exclusive island hotel. Budva, a coastal tourist resort in Montenegro. It is often called "Montenegrin Miami".

Old City of Kotor~ an ancient trade center. The Old Town has a well-preserved collection of buildings, churches, squares and stone streets that date back to the middle ages.

A brief walking tour to visit the Cathedral St Tryphon.

DAY 4 DUBROVNIK - (230KM) SPLIT

Today, be in awe as you set eyes on Dubrovnik with its orange-hued roofs, ancient city walls, marble streets and baroque buildings. Designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the city's landmarks such as Rector's Palace, Clock Tower, the city walls, Onofrio Fountain, Orlando's Column and Sponza Palace will not fail to impress. Imagine yourself living in medieval times as you see Dominican Monastery and Franciscan Monastery up close, which also houses Europe's 3rd-oldest pharmacy. Spend the rest of your day at leisure to explore the old town, stroll through the markets, enjoy a drink in a seaside cafe or simply relax.

Travel along the coast to soak up the exuberance of the Dalmatian city of Split as you embark on a city tour through its most important sights. Relive the days of the past as you come face-to-face with Diocletian's Palace, Temple of Jupiter and Cathedral of St Domnius. With dramatic coastlines and turquoise waters of the Adriatic surrounding remnants of Roman, Renaissance and Gothic buildings, this charming city is a sight to behold.

DAY 5 SPLIT - (89KM) SIBENIK - (89KM) ZADAR

St Mihovil Fortress and Church, It is erected on the altitude of 70 m above the sea level. Judging from its size and exterior it belongs to 15th – 16th century. We continue to Split. Split is a Mediterranean city on the eastern shores of the Adriatic Sea.

Travel to Sibenik. Sibenik Cathedral, it is also the most important Renaissance architectural monument in the entire country. Since 2000, the Cathedral has been on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Zadar walking tour included City walls, Town Gate and Western Quay, visit St Dona's Church, it was built in the 9th Century and is one of the largest examples of Byzantine architecture in Dalmatia. It was originally named the Church of the Holy Trinity but was later changed and named for Bishop Donat. St Donat is one of the main architectural highlights of Zadar. View the Roman forum and see the Sea organ, it is an architectural object which plays music by way of sea waves and tubes located underneath a set of large marble steps.

DAY 6 ZADAR - (120KM) PLITVICE

The Plitvice National Park is an UNESCO world heritage since year 1979. The beauty of the National Park lies in its sixteen lakes, inter-connected by a series of waterfalls and set in deep woodland populated by deer, bears, wolves, boars and rare bird species. You will take a boat ride to explore the park. Drive to Zadar - a historical center of Dalmatia as well as the seat of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Zadar.

DAY 7 STOJNA - (54KM) LJUBLJANA

Postojna Caves – the queen of the entire karst underground kingdom. Two millions years and 27km long, the system of subterranean caves is one of the most easily accessible networks underground caves in the world. Experience on a ride by electric train through a series of cave hall with stalagmite, lakes and translucent curtains create unforgettable impression whereby you can see the “human fish” in the cave.

DAY 8 LJUBLJANA - (55KM) BLEED - (198KM) ZAGREB (Croatia)

Ljubljana - Capital of Slovenia, city orientation tour included St Peter Church, cross the Triple Bridge and the Dragon Bridge, and view the St Nicholas Cathedral. Ljubljana castle with cable car - only one of the castles in the city and the most visited. Bled -- take a boat ride in the Lake Bled – is the greatest attraction is its crystal blue-green lake, the lake is lovely to behold from almost any vantage point. Bled Castle, a medieval castle built on a precipice above the city of Bled in Slovenia, overlooking Lake Bled.

DAY 9 ZAGREB / SIN

Zagreb - capital and the largest city in Croatia, a typical Central European town. We will bring you to the Lower and Upper town of Zagreb. Marshal Tito's Square – one of the biggest squares in Zagreb. Croatian National Theater and Opera House, The theatre was first established as the Croatian National Theatre in 1860. Stone Gate and The Litter Chapel ~ a painting of the Mother of God. Transfer to airport for your flight back to SIN.
