BROWN LINE - TOUR ITINERARY

[Thursday] Budapest → Zagreb (350 km)

In the morning, you will have a wonderful drive to the *Croatian capital Zagreb*. This is a city which went through wars, but the buildings are still well preserved. The ancient city is full of beautiful Gothic architecture, decorations are exquisitely crafted. Together with Mediterranean cuisine and locally produced wines, as well as the friendly Croatian hospitality, Zagreb is sure to be a wonderful experience. You will visit the city's highlights such as the *Zagreb Cathedral*, the *Ban Jelačić Square* and the *Church of St. Mark*.

Overnight stay in Zagreb or city nearby (minimum 3* hotel)

[Friday] Zagreb → Plitvice Lakes National Park → Zadar (275 km)

Today you will enjoy a guided tour into the *Plitvice Lakes National Park*, known as the Jiuzhaigou of Europe. It consists of 16 lakes joined by waterfalls, walkways and hiking trails. In the dense mountains, layers of travertine barriers make a natural dam, forming fairy tale lakes. The calcium carbonate rich water has a special silver colour, mirroring the trees on its surface and forming tiny crystals, the view is stunning. Surrounded by trees, the lakes have the perfect tranquil atmosphere. *Overnight stay in Zadar or city nearby (minimum 3* hotel)*

[Saturday] Zadar→ Split → Neum (322 km)

After breakfast you enter the ancient city of **Zadar**. The city has a strong religious atmosphere, still retaining the narrow streets and buildings of the middle ages. It's like going back in time. Close to the waterfront, you can admire the modern **Sea Organ** and **Sun Salutation**, an amazing solar light display. Then you will head to **Split**, the second largest city in Croatia. The city has many ancient Roman style buildings, which date back to over 1,700 years. The most famous are the ruins of **Diocletian's Palace**, which was built in the fourth century AD. Overnight stay in Neum or city nearby (minimum 3* hotel)

[Sunday] Neum → Dubrovnik → Neum (150 km)

The Nobel Prize winning writer Bernard Shaw once said: "If you want to see heaven on earth, come to Dubrovnik". He wasn't exaggerating. *Dubrovnik* is a place where people can fall in love at first sight. You must not miss exploring this seaside city that inspired Miyazaki's masterpiece 'The Witch's Delivery Service', and is 'King's Landing' in Game of Thrones! You see the famous places: *the old town*, the city walls, the defensive tower, *the Rector's Palace*, and the *Franciscan Monastery*. You can take a cable car to go up in the mountain and admire the beauty of the city. Your day of heaven on earth ends with an overnight stay in Neum or city nearby. *Overnight stay in Neum or city nearby (minimum 3* hotel)*

[Monday] Neum → Počitelj → Blagaj → Mostar → Sarajevo (186 km)

The Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina is the focus of today's itinerary and was originally one of the six socialist republics of the former Yugoslavia. First stop today is **Počitelj**, the stepped medieval fortress village, which has now been included in the World Cultural Heritage List. You also see stunning **Blagaj** with its **Dervish Monastery** nestled into a 200 meter high cliff and surrounded by crystal clear streams. Then you head on to the ancient city of **Mostar**, to cross the magnificent ancient arch bridge and capture the beautiful scenery on both sides of the river. After visiting this ancient city of poetry and paintings, you drive to the hotel and stay in Sarajevo or city nearby (minimum 3* hotel)

[Tuesday] Sarajevo → Vinkovci (220 km)

Sarajevo was once an important gateway to the East. This city, which combines different religions and cultures, has a very different European style. As if reborn after a fire, it was recently selected by Lonely Planet as one of the top ten travel destinations in the world. Its profound historical imprint, which includes the assassination at the **Latin Bridge** that caused the First World War, and the "Sarajevo Meeting of Cultures Line" on the ground, can still be found in the **Old Town**. The rebirth and transformation of Sarajevo is reflected in the modern architecture of the new city. After the visit, you cross the border into Croatia. Overnight stay in Vinkovci or city nearby (minimum 3* hotel)

[Wednesday] Vinkovci → Pecs → Budapest (367 km)

Departing in the morning and returning to Hungary – you visit **Pecs**. Located between the Danube and the Drava, it is one of the most attractive cities in Hungary, with a pleasant climate and long history. Pecs also features a magnificent museum and the best Turkish ruins in the country. Pecs is known for music, opera and ballet. Highlight is the **Pécs Cathedral** towering over central **Szent István Square**. You drive back to Budapest in the afternoon. Optional: if post-hotel is chosen, overnight stay in Budapest or city nearby (minimum 3* hotel)

A. MAKING A RESERVATION

- (1) Please complete all the information in the booking form.
- (2) Passport must be valid for at least 6 months from the day you arrive at your destination.

B. TOUR FARE INCLUDES

- (1) Hotel accommodation in a comfortable 3-star hotel, twin room with private facilities.
- (2) Daily continental breakfast.
- (3) The services of an experienced tour manager
- (4) Sightseeing and orientation tours included in the itinerary.
- (5) Daily transportation on modern air-conditioned coaches.
- (6) Professional coach driver.

C. INSURANCE



(1) Purchase of European travel insurance is strongly recommended. Please ensure that you are suitably insured for your entire trip.

ADDITIONAL PASSENGER INFORMATION

- (1) Our professional tour managers will help you to explore and make the most out of your time. Their love and knowledge for the destinations will bring the holiday to life. The gratuity for the tour manager and driver is not included in the tour price. Our mandatory gratuity is €7 per person per day (€5 for the tour manager and €2 for the driver) both for adults and children. Gratuity will be collected by the tour manager in cash (Euros) whilst on tour.
- (2) Please present the voucher to the tour manager when you board the coach. goEUgo cannot be held liable for delay or expenses incurred due to passenger's negligence, causing them to miss the pick-up at the designated joining point. For any serious incidents please call our emergency number.
- (3) Please remember to pack any prescribed medication, motion sickness medication, and other essentials for personal use.
- (4) Please ensure that you have sufficient cash to pay for entrance tickets at your own expense as per the optional price lists, meals, tips, city taxes/entrance fees and expenses not included in our tour price and itinerary.
- (5) Please don't bring any illegal contraband goods into or smuggle items forbidden by law out of each country you are visiting. goEUgo will not be held liable and any losses, expenses. Fines are the responsibility of the passengers.
- (6) Whilst every effort is made to operate this tour as advertised, on occasion it may be necessary to make changes to the accommodation, the routing or order of an itinerary. Compensation will not be payable for alterations to the itinerary or nightly accommodation
- (7) For minors under 18 years of age, pregnant women or elderly (70+) are obliged to be accompanied by at least one (under 65) adult relative or friend. Please note: passengers (pregnant women or elderly people) need to sign the "Participation Commitment Disclaimer" for the protection of both parties. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

TOUR VOUCHERS

Once you have forwarded all the travel vouchers to your customers, please remind them they must take printed copies of all the vouchers and present these to the tour manager, hotel and transfer service. MEALS

Daily continental breakfast is included in the tour price, for all other meals; lunches and dinners the tour manager will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants/cafés.



LUGGAGE

The customer will be responsible for all their personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, please advise your customers that they must be prepared to carry their own suitcase from the coach to their hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the uploading and offloading of their luggage from the coach. Every client is only allowed to bring one luggage on board (Weight below 30kg, the sum of three sizes must not exceed 158 cm). If client bring more than one luggage (if the coach has enough space) we will have to charge 5 Euros every day for each additional luggage. Apologies for any inconveniences caused.

MOBILITY

Because goEUgo cannot provide individual assistance to travellers during the tours and our coaches are not equipped with wheelchair access, unfortunately our tours are currently not suitable for wheelchair users and those less mobile.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted on coaches provided by goEUgo. Smoking is also banned in some cafes', restaurants and public places in Europe. Please remind your customers to be aware of this law throughout the tour.

SAFETY
