ITINERARY

Kusadasi Ephesus distence is 20 Km . Departure from hotel or Harbour to Ephesus. it takes from Kusadasi 30 minutes, from Izmir 1 hour.

We visiting Ephesus - one of the best-preserved classical cities in the eastern Mediterranean and a great example of Roman architecture. When you walk on marbel street of Ephesus like by Cleopatra and Mark Antony, feel privilege your selve.

Biblical Ephesus: Ephesus is one of the Seven Churches of Revelation (Rev. 1: 11). In ancient days, Ancient Ephesus was a bustling port town of 250,000, The St. Paul's first visit to Ephesus was brief - during his second missionary tour (Acts 18:19-21). His second visit lasted about three years - during his third missionary tour (Acts 19:1 to 20:31). Luke's account of the worship of Diana appears in Acts 19:34-35. In John's letter to Ephesus, Ephesus receives praise for its perseverance, but criticism for forsaking its first love. John's 1st letter was addressed to the church of Ephesus. In that day Ephesus was the chief city of Asia Minor and ranked with Antioch and Jerusalem as one of the chief cities in the Christian world. Message was Ephesus change of intensity of devotion to Christ. John called for repentance.

Within Ephesus you will be seeing **Harbour Street**, the Marble Street, **Ephesus Grand Theater** which is capacity seating for 25,000 persons, the gate of Mihridates and Mazues, Commercial Agora, latrina, the Scolastica Baths, , the **Hercules gate**, the famous **Celsus Library**, Trajan Fountain, Curetes Street, Polio Fountain, Memnius Monument, the Temple of Domitian, **Temple of Hadrian**, the Prytaneion, the State Agora and Odeon. House of Virgin Mary is located on the top of the "Bulbul" mountain 8 km from Ephesus, Virgin Mary may have spent her last years at the Bulbul hill. She have come in this area together with Saint John, who spent several years in the area to spread Christianity. During the visiting you may feel the mystical holly atmosphere around Virgin Maria's house area.

Temple of Artemis: Temple of Artemis is one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. In a flat area of first ancient Ephesus, centuries later it became a big bog. Because of Meander river aluvions destroyed Artemis Temple. Today there are the remains of the foundations of this wonderful hellenistic structure. After being destroyed and rebuilt in the second century, the Temple of Artemis was again demolished by earthquakes and was finally dismissed from the Goths. The most beautiful marble remains of this Artemision temple are on display at the British Museum in London since the long years.

St. John Church: Beleived to be an evangelist St. John had spent last years of his life in the around Ephesus and buried in the southern slope of Selcuk's Ayosolug Hill. After St John's death, a small chapel was built on the tomb. During the reign of the Byzantine emperor Justinianus (527-565 AD), he was converted into a magnificent basilica. St John (the Apostle John) was the author of

the Fourth Gospel and Revelation.

Isabey Mosque; Isa Bey Mosque is located in the district of Selcuk in Izmir, between the Temple of Artemis and the Church of Saint Jean. It was built by Aydınoğlu İsa Bey in 1375. Architect Şamlı Ali's work. İsa Bey Mosque is one of the oldest and most famous works of Turkish architectural history in the Anatolian Principal period.

What makes the area so special is that the temples of three different religions are side by side. The first is the temple of the goddess Artemis Temple before the dawn of the Prophet Jesus (Gamanism), the second is the Saint John Church, one of the symbolic churches of Christianity, and the third isabey

mosque, the place of worship of Muslims. These three places of worship give the region a mystical atmosphere. Arrivel and overnight at Kusadasi. B.L.D.
