Taksim Square – Istiklal Avenue – French Street – Antique Shops - Nevizade
After breakfast, meet your guide in hotel lobby at 08:30 am or 13:00 pm to start our tour in Istanbul.
Visit Taksim Square – Istiklal Avenue – French Street – Antique Shops - Nevizade Break time for Lunch in a local Turkish restaurant. End of the tour drop to hotel overnight in Istanbul.

Places To Visit

Taksim Square - Taksim Square is the symbol square of Istanbul. Appointments are given here is the point of love and business meeting. It is the heart of modern Istanbul, located near the city's water distribution system in the late 1800s. Taksim Square is the heart of the city that does not sleep. Independence Monument in the square, and the military commander of the Republic of Turkey's founder, Kemal Ataturk.

Istiklal Street – Istiklal Caddesi (Istiklal Street) formerly Grande Rue de Pera, the heart of Beyoğlu, the more modern district of Istanbul in the 19th century. Life on Istaklal Street never stops and does not sleep. Non stop. The most popular shopping, sightseeing and elegant restaurants of the city are now reserved for pedestrians, with housings and boutiques, cafes, consulates, restaurants, galleries, cinemas and theater banks.

When travelers of the 19th century spoke of Istanbul as the Paris of the East, they were thinking about Grande Rue de Pera (Istiklal Street) and its semi-European, semi-Asian culture. Istiklal Street starts in Taksim Square in the heart of modern Istanbul, you can walk in the crowded and cheerful atmosphere along the way and take a short stroll with Nostalgic Tram.

French Street - The French Street on Istiklal Street in Beyoglu district of Istanbul is a street with an authentic and very atmosphere, with the renewal of Algeria Street, a former and derelict street on the back of Galatasaray High School, as the French Street. Project carried out by Parisian architects. The project lasted two years and included restoration of buildings and pavements. Street heaters and a special sound system were installed, and all of them were imported from France century-old coal gas lamps, which contributed to the unique atmosphere in the quarter.

The French Street, which aims to reflect French culture, has nice cafes, restaurants and art centers. The French Street is also one of the most popular destinations for those who want to have a nice day on Istiklal Street. The beautifully restored terraced buildings feature a range of charming boutiques and galleries specializing in French cuisine and wines, as well as bakeries, wine houses, cafes and restaurants. The street consists of a staircase and the cafes have tables and chairs on the right and left of the street. You can sit here and enjoy the views of the street as well as have a drink with friends or lover. The French Street also has a different view at night with its illumination. The street and cafes illuminated by colorful lights look quite beautiful.

Antique Shops - Taksim to Istiklal Street is reached on foot, shopping in terms of all kinds of appeal to the antique shops of Beyoglu, to discover the treasures they need to explore. Bookstores and

antique shops invite you to the pleasures of the past. The antique shops are so valuable that they contain all the time, sometimes you are willing to touch or even look. Unique pieces with different time periods and stories shine on dusty shelves.

Nevizade Street - Cicek passage and Nevizade street are located in the central part of Istiklal Street. There are many meyhane (Turkish Taverna) and restaurants in Nevizade street and the cicek passage. Usually their tables are in a bright active atmosphere outside. After a few minutes you're certain to have made some new friends among the Turkish and foreign diners. Enjoy your drinks with delicious appetizers and main dishes. You can have intimate friendships and conversations with your neighbors on the side table. Enjoy the time of singing with street musicians. Your dining at Nevizade Street will be the most memorable of your Turkey trip.
