<b>Day 3 TUE.</b>	<p><b>KUSADASI (Turkey) – PATMOS: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b></p> <p><b>Kusadasi: Take the included tour Ancient Ephesus through the Ages - Hellenistic and Roman (KUS-02).</b> At Ancient Ephesus you find Immortal relics of the Hellenistic, Roman and Early Christian era. At the archaeological site you will be given a guided tour among the Agora, the Odeon, the Library of Celsus, the marble-paved main Street of Kouretes, the Baths of Scholastica, Trajan’s Fountain, the Public Latrines, the Residences of the Patricians, the Prytaneum, the Temple of Hadrian... The Great Theatre, built in the 4th century B.C., could accommodate 24,000 spectators and it is famous even nowadays for its acoustics. The finds from the excavations, which have yet brought to light only 13% of ancient Ephesus, reside in the Archaeological Museum of Ephesus, in the city of Selcuk. During the excursion you will have the opportunity to do some shopping such as carpets, jewelry, leather and other souvenirs.</p> <p><b>Patmos:</b> The Holy island where St. John wrote The Revelation, known as Jerusalem of the Aegean Sea. At leisure or take an optional tour to visit the Monastery and Grotto of St. John. In the evening, enjoy the live on board entertainment or try your luck in the casino. Overnight on board.</p>																																				
<b>Day 4 WED.</b>	<p><b>RHODES: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b></p> <p><b>Rhodes: Take the included Medieval tour – Acropolis of Lindos and Citadel of the Knights (RHO-01).</b> Lindos is situated 55 km (40 miles) from the city of Rhodes and “bears” above it the Acropolis of Lindos, with the ancient Temple of Athena, built in 300 B.C. Here and there you will come across the captains’ mansions, built between the 16th and 18th century. In the centre of the village lives and breathes the Church of the Virgin Mary (Panagia) of Lindos, with frescoes from the 15th century. Ascend to the Acropolis of Lindos. Here lies the Temple of Athena, of Doric order, which was erected on the location of an older monument. The ancient city-state of Lindos was for many centuries the most important on the island. It reached its heyday in the 6th century B.C. At the old city of Rhodes you will go through D’Amboise Gate to walk on the Street of the Knights. Along this street you will find the residences of the Knights, separated according to Order, which bear until today their corresponding crests. In the evening, enjoy the live on-board entertainment or try your luck in the casino. Overnight on board.</p>																																				
<b>Day 5 THU.</b>	<p><b>CRETE (HERAKLION) – SANTORINI: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b></p> <p><b>Heraklion</b>, the capital of Crete. At leisure or take an optional tour to visit the fantastic ruins of the <u>Palace of Knossos</u>. The elaborate palace is believed to be the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos (Minotaur legend) and the seat of the Minoan civilization.</p>																																				

	<b>Santorini:</b> at leisure on the island of Santorini which was formed by the eruption of the volcano in 1600 BC. In the evening, enjoy the live on-board entertainment or try your luck in the casino. Overnight on board.
<b>Day 6 FRI. Daily Service DEP08.45 - RET13.45 terminal</b>	<b>CRUISE ARRIVAL ATHENS</b>  - <b>HALF DAY ATHENS SIGHTSEEING</b>  : <b>(Breakfast)</b> Breakfast on board. Disembark. Meet at the Athens port of Piraeus and transfer to the tour terminal for your half day morning tour. See <u>Syntagma Square</u> , the <u>House of Parliament</u> , the <u>Memorial to the Unknown Soldier</u> , the <u>Athens Academy</u> , the <u>University</u> , the <u>National Library</u> and the <u>Hadrian's Arch</u> . Pass by the <u>Temple of Olympian Zeus</u> and visit the <u>Panathenaic Stadium</u> where the first Olympic Games of the modern era were held in 1896. On the <b>Acropolis</b> visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: the <u>Propylaea</u> , the <u>Temple of Athena Nike</u> , the <u>Erechtheion</u> and finally "the harmony between material and spirit", the <u>Parthenon</u> . Continue and visit the place where at last the statues found their home and admire the wonders of the classical era, the <b>museum of Acropolis</b> . At the end of the tour, drop off at the hotel. Remainder of the day at own leisure. Overnight in Athens Hotel.
<b>Day 7 SAT. DEP08.45 terminal</b>	<b>4 DAYS CLASSICAL TOUR</b>  : <b>ATHENS – ARGOLIS (Corinth Canal, Epidaurus, Nafplion, Mycenae) – OLYMPIA: (Breakfast, Dinner)</b> Breakfast in the hotel. Pickup from the hotel for your 4 days Classical tour. Depart Athens and stop to see the <u>Corinth Canal</u> . Drive onto and visit the ancient <u>theatre of Epidaurus</u> famous for its acoustics. See the town of <b>Nafplion</b> before arriving in <b>Mycenae</b> . Visit the <u>archaeological site</u> and the <u>Royal Tomb of Agammemnon</u> (The leader of the Troy War). Continue across the central Peloponnese to <b>Olympia</b> , the cradle of the Olympic Games. From here, the original Olympic Flame begins its journey to the Olympic Games. Dinner in the hotel. Overnight in Olympia hotel.
<b>Day 8 SUN.</b>	<b>4 DAYS CLASSICAL TOUR: OLYMPIA – DELPHI: (Breakfast, Dinner)</b> Breakfast in the hotel. Visit the original <u>Olympic Stadium</u> and the <b>archaeological museum</b> . Then drive north to Patras and cross the new bridge over the Corinthian Bay from Rion to Antirion. Continue via the towns of Nafpaktos and Itea to <b>Delphi</b> . Dinner in the hotel. Overnight in Delphi hotel.
<b>Day 9 MON.</b>	<b>4 DAYS CLASSICAL TOUR: DELPHI – KALAMBAKA (METEORA): (Breakfast, Dinner)</b> Breakfast in the hotel. Visit the <u>archaeological site</u> of <b>Delphi</b> on the slopes of Mount Parnassus. See the <u>Sanctuary of Apollo Pythios</u> , <u>Castalia Spring</u> and the <b>museum</b> . In the afternoon leave Delphi for an interesting trip through Central Greece to <b>Kalambaka (Meteora)</b> . Dinner in the hotel. Overnight in Kalambaka (Meteora) hotel.
<b>Day 10 TUE. RET19.00 terminal</b>	<b>4 DAYS CLASSICAL TOUR: KALAMBAKA (METEORA) – ATHENS: (Breakfast)</b> Breakfast in the hotel. Visit <u>Meteora</u> with its impressive scenery, ageless <u>monasteries</u> , suspended between earth and sky. Inside, see priceless historical and religious treasures. Return to Athens via Trikala, Lamia, Thermopylae and drop off at the hotel. Overnight in Athens hotel.
<b>Day 11 WED.</b>	<b>ATHENS DEPARTURE</b>  : <b>(Breakfast)</b> Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to the airport included or, extend your stay in Greece.
