<p><b>Day 3</b> <b>TUE.</b></p>	<p><b>KUSADASI (Turkey) – PATMOS:</b> (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</p> <p><b>Kusadasi:</b> <u>Take the included tour Ancient Ephesus through the Ages - Hellenistic and Roman (KUS-02).</u> At Ancient Ephesus you find Immortal relics of the Hellenistic, Roman and Early Christian era. At the archaeological site you will be given a guided tour among the Agora, the Odeon, the Library of Celsus, the marble-paved main Street of Kouretes, the Baths of Scholastica, Trajan’s Fountain, the Public Latrines, the Residences of the Patricians, the Prytaneum, the Temple of Hadrian... The Great Theatre, built in the 4th century B.C., could accommodate 24,000 spectators and it is famous even nowadays for its acoustics. The finds from the excavations, which have yet brought to light only 13% of ancient Ephesus, reside in the Archaeological Museum of Ephesus, in the city of Selcuk. During the excursion you will have the opportunity to do some shopping such as carpets, jewelry, leather and other souvenirs.</p> <p><b>Patmos:</b> The Holy island where St. John wrote The Revelation, known as Jerusalem of the Aegean Sea. At leisure or take an optional tour to visit the Monastery and Grotto of St. John. In the evening, enjoy the live on board entertainment or try your luck in the casino. Overnight on board.</p>																																				
<p><b>Day 4</b> <b>WED.</b></p>	<p><b>RHODES:</b> (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</p> <p><b>Rhodes:</b> <u>Take the included Medieval tour – Acropolis of Lindos and Citadel of the Knights (RHO-01).</u> Lindos is situated 55 km (40 miles) from the city of Rhodes and “bears” above it the Acropolis of Lindos, with the ancient Temple of Athena, built in 300 B.C. Here and there you will come across the captains’ mansions, built between the 16th and 18th century. In the centre of the village lives and breathes the Church of the Virgin Mary (Panagia) of Lindos, with frescoes from the 15th century. Ascend to the Acropolis of Lindos. Here lies the Temple of Athena, of Doric order, which was erected on the location of an older monument. The ancient city-state of Lindos was for many centuries the most important on the island. It reached its heyday in the 6th century B.C. At the old city of Rhodes you will go through D’Amboise Gate to walk on the Street of the Knights. Along this street you will find the residences of the Knights, separated according to Order, which bear until today their corresponding crests. In the evening, enjoy the live on board entertainment or try your luck in the casino. Overnight on board.</p>																																				
<p><b>Day 5</b> <b>THU.</b></p>	<p><b>CRETE (HERAKLION) – SANTORINI:</b> (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</p> <p><b>Heraklion</b>, the capital of Crete. At leisure or take an optional tour to visit the fantastic ruins of the Palace</p>																																				

	of Knossos. The elaborate palace is believed to be the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos (Minotaur legend) and the seat of the Minoan civilization. At leisure on the amazing island of <b>Santorini</b> (formed by the eruption of the volcano 1600 BC). The sight is the most breathtaking of all Greek islands and perhaps of the world. In the evening, enjoy the live on board entertainment or try your luck in the casino. Overnight on board.
<b>Day 6 FRI.</b>	<b>CRUISE ARRIVAL ATHENS</b> 🚗: <b>(Breakfast)</b> Breakfast on board. Disembark. Meet at the Athens port of Piraeus and transfer to the hotel. Remainder of the day at own leisure. Overnight in Athens Hotel.
<b>Day 7 SAT.</b>  <i>Daily Service</i> <b>DEP08.45</b>  <b>RET13.30</b> <i>terminal</i>	<b>HALF DAY ATHENS SIGHTSEEING</b> 🚌: <b>(Breakfast)</b> Breakfast in the hotel. Pickup from the hotel for your half day morning tour. See <u>Syntagma Square</u> , the <u>House of Parliament</u> , the <u>Memorial to the Unknown Soldier</u> , the <u>Athens Academy</u> , the <u>University</u> , the <u>National Library</u> and the <u>Hadrian's Arch</u> . Pass by the <u>Temple of Olympian Zeus</u> and visit the <u>Panathenaic Stadium</u> where the first Olympic Games of the modern era were held in 1896. On the <b>Acropolis</b> visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: the <u>Propylaea</u> , the <u>Temple of Athena Nike</u> , the <u>Erechtheion</u> and finally "the harmony between material and spirit", the <u>Parthenon</u> . Continue and visit the place where at last the statues found their home and admire the wonders of the classical era, the <b>museum of Acropolis</b> . At the end of the tour, drop off at the hotel or at the city centre. Remainder of the day at own leisure. Overnight in Athens Hotel.
<b>Day 8 SUN.</b>	<b>ATHENS DEPARTURE</b> 🚗: <b>(Breakfast)</b> Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to the airport included or, extend your stay in Greece.
