Itinerary:

Day 1 Barcelona

(D)

On arrival at Barcelona Airport, you will meet your coach and proceed directly for **Guided Panoramic City Tour of Barcelona**. In your city tour you will visit the main attractions around Barcelona that are quite famous for its unique architecture. For example La Sagrada Familia, the largest Catholic church in Catalunya, built in 1882 with 18 unique towers and Park Guell built in 1914, which should be the elite residential area of magnates in the city. Other attractions in the city are La Monumental which was once a stadium between matador and bull, the Arc de Triomf built as the main entrance during the 1888 Barcelona World Fair, taking a photo of a magnificent fountain pool in Citadel Park and Port Olimpic, a marina area built especially when Barcelona hosted the 1992 Olympic Games. Later you can take a stroll around Placa De Catalunya, La Rambla and the Gothic Quarter which are the city's commercial hub triangles before they travel to Camp Nou Stadium, which is the official stadium of FC Barcelona soccer team which line up the world's best players such as Leo Messi, Andreas Iniesta, Luis Suarez and others. Later check in Hotel. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel NH Sant Boi (Tourist Class) or Tryp Barcelona Aeropuerto Hotel (First Class) or similar.**

Day 2 Barcelona – Valencia

(B/D)

Breakfast at Hotel. We proceed to Valencia. It is located on the east coast of Spain, is the capital of the autonomous community of Valencia and the third-largest city in Spain after Madrid and Barcelona, with around 800,000 inhabitants in the administrative centre. The Port of Valencia is the 5th busiest container port in Europe and the busiest container port on the Mediterranean Sea. Arrive and take a **Short orientation tour of Valencia (Without Guide)**. Visit the pedestrian historic center of Valencia, where you'll find ancient Roman ruins, Saint Mary's Cathedral, several central plazas, including main administrative Plaza Ayuntamiento, and the Lonja Silk Exchange (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), the world's greatest example of gothic architecture and the "Wall Street" of Valencia during medieval times. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel Holiday Inn Express Valencia San Luis (Tourist Class) or NH Valencia Las Artes (First Class) or similar.**

Day 3 Valencia - Granada

(B/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning some free time to explore Valencia. We depart to Granada around 11am. Today we proceed to Granada Enjoy breathtaking sights enroute. Granada is one of the world's most famous Al-Andalus towns with its iconic Alhambra Palace. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel BS Principe Felipe (Tourist Class) or Hotel Saray (First Class) or similar.**

Day 4 Granada - Cordoba

(B/D)

Breakfast at Hotel. This morning you will visit the **Alhambra Palace (Admission included)** which was originally built as a fort before being renovated into a castle by the government of the Granada Nasri Kingdom of the Moorish. An outstanding landmark ever built by the Islamic government in Spain, the Alhambra is the door to the Moorish culture, it certainly promises a beautiful view of the carved wall of Quranic calligraphy and flower-patterned engraving. Visit The Generalife, a royal summer break palace adorned with patios, pools, green trees, springs and pillars linked to the Alhambra via a covered walkway. The garden landscape that is too beautiful will definitely make the guests not miss the opportunity to photograph here. In the late afternoon we proceed to Cordoba. Arrive and Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel Eurostars Maimonides (Tourist Class) or NH Collection Amistad Córdoba (First Class) or similar.**

Day 5 Cordoba-Seville

(B/D)

Breakfast at Hotel. We proceed on a **Guided Panoramic Tour of Cordoba**. We start our tour by a visit of Mezquita, the mosques built with the best Islamic architecture in the world. Known as the Cathedral Mosque of Cordoba, this mosque was renovated into a church after the fall of the Islamic empire. Among the effects of the mosque that can still be seen include the engraving of Quranic verses on the walls of the mosque, pole, tower and mihrab. The visit was continued to the Jewish Quarter, a Jewish neighborhood that was given religious freedom and placement during Almohad's Islamic reign. Not only is it surrounded by white-painted houses and colorful colorful patios, even Muslim surau here are still maintained and used today. Next visit Casa Andalusi, a museum house from the 12th century which showcases Islamic culture during the Middle Ages in Cordoba and Roman relics mosaics. Mid afternoon we proceed to Seville. Upon arrival we proceed for a **Guided City Tour of Seville**. We start the tour with a visit to Seville Cathedral, the world's largest Gothic architecture. The church was originally a mosque built during the reign of Almohad, before being demolished and rebuilt as a Roman Catholic church after the collapse of the Islamic empire with the original tower of the mosque named Giralda Tower still standing next to it including the Orange Tree Courtyard which is part of the mosque's remains . Visit the Santa Cruz Quarter, the Medieval historic neighborhood and adjacent to the former Real Alcazar palace belonging to the Moorish Islamic kingdom. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel Eurostars Regina (Tourist Class) or Hilton Garden Inn Sevilla**

(First Class) or similar.

Day 6 Seville - Sintra - Lisbon

(B/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Today we proceed to Lisbon via Sintra. We stop for an **Orientation Tour of Sintra (Without Guide)**. which is famous for the charm of Palace Da Pena, a brightly colored castle and decorated with fortifications and mythical statues, is one of the tourist attractions to Portugal with the best example of Romantic architecture from the 19th century. head to Lisbon. **Overnight at Hotel Holiday Inn Express Lisbon Airport (Tourist Class) or NH Lisboa Campo Grande (First Class) or similar.**

Day 7 Lisbon - Merida

(B/D)

Breakfast at hotel, We proceed for a **Guided Panoramic City Tour of Lisbon** and we will visit Rossio Square, Lisbon's lively square, surrounded by Baroque fountains, historical monuments and monuments and the Dona Maria II National Theater building. Photo Stop at Jeronimos Monastery, a monastery with the finest Portuguese-Gothic Manueline architecture that holds the tomb of Vasco da Gama, a Portuguese explorer who was the first to sail directly from Europe to India. Visit the Belem Tower, the 16th-century fortress tower and the 171-foot Monument to the Discoveries shaped like a ship in 1940 to celebrate the achievement of the Portuguese explorer. In the afternoon we will proceed to Merida. Merida is the capital of western Spain's Extremadura region, was founded by the Romans in the 1st century B.C. Remains of the ancient city include the still-used Teatro Romano, which has a double tier of columns rising onstage. The ancient Puente Romano, a 792m bridge spanning the Río Guadiana, adjoins the Alcazaba, a 9th-century Islamic fortress built over Roman walls. Dinner at Hotel. **Overnight at Hotel Lisboa (Tourist Class) or Ilunion Golf Badajoz (First Class) or similar.**

Day 8 Merida - Madrid

Breakfast at Hotel. This morning you are free to explore Merida on your own. Later mid afternoon we proceed to Madrid. Arrive in Madrid and Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel Best Western Hotel Villa de Barajas (Tourist Class) or Tryp Madrid Alameda Aeropuerto Hotel (First Class) or similar.**

Day 9 Madrid

Breakfast at Hotel, Today we embark on a **Guided Panoramic City Tour of Madrid**, we start with the royal palace which with its famous Baroque architecture, past the Prado Museum which houses the greatest European artwork from the 12th to the 20th century, the Cibeles and the Neptune Fountains of 2 pools a fountain located opposite and close to Plaza de la Cibeles; square with cothe architect is characterized by the Neo-classic architecture and also the Puerta de Alcala which is a magnificent gate standing in Plaza de la Independencia and built by King Carlos III in the 18th century and the Puerta del Sol area, which is the economic and shopping center of this city. Afternoon we will visit the famous football stadium known as Estadio Santiago Bernabeu, the official football club of Real Madrid. You can take panoramic photos of this stadium. Later we have some free time for shopping in Madrid. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel (Tourist Class) or (First Class) or similar.**

Day 10 Madrid

Breakfast at Hotel. Day free at leisure until departure transfer to Madrid Airport
