**Itinerary:**

**Day 1 Sarejevo**

**(D)**

Meet and greet upon arrival at Sarajevo International Airport, Proceed directly for **Guided Panoramic City Tour of Sarajevo**. Visit the Tunnel of Hope, a house in which the Bosnian tunnel enters the Serbian enclosure over the city of Sarajevo for food and medicines. Then proceed the Old Town Bazaar in the center of Sarajevo to shop while taking photos at Sebilj, a wooden monument built in 1753, praying at the Gazi

Husrev-bey Mosque which is the largest mosque in the country built in 1530 in the Ottoman period, Sahat Kula, a clock tower built as early as the 17th century, the Sacred Heart Cathedral which is quite famous for its construction and in front of it is one of the sites of Sarajevo Roses, the name given to the impact of a mortar bomb blast during the Bosnian War redesigned in red and photographed in City Hall, also known as Vijecnica. Later Dinner and check in hotel **Overnight at Hotel Grabovac (Tourist Class) or Hotel Mirjana & Rastoke (First Class) or similar.**

#### **Day 2 Sarajevo – Mostar**

**(B/D)**

Breakfast at hotel. Today we will proceed into the country of Bosnia and Herzegovina and visit the town of Mostar with attractions such as Old Bridge Stari Most which is a tourism icon to the village and country, Tara and Halebija Towers flanking the bridge, the Karadoz Bey Mosque built in 1554 by architect Mimar Sinan is one of the most beautiful mosques in the country and the Turkish Hammam dating back to the 16th century since the Ottoman rule. Some free time for shopping at Kujundziluk Old Bazaar which sells a wide range of local produce and souvenirs. Dinner and check in hotel. **Overnight at Hotel Delfin (Tourist Class) or Torretta Palace Hotel (First Class) or similar.**

#### **Day 3 Mostar - Durbrovnik**

**(B/D)**

Breakfast at the hotel. We proceed to Dubrovnik. **Guided Half Day City Tour of Dubrovnik** to see tourist attractions there such as the Rector's Palace which was once the city's royal court between the 14th and 18th centuries, the Franciscan Church and Monastery built in 1360 but has been several times destroyed the disaster deck, the Museum of Croatian War of Independence, Sponza Palace, the Clock Tower and Orlando's Column depicting the 8th century Dubrovnik warrior located at Luza Square Stradun. Dinner and check in hotel. **Overnight at Valamar Club Dubrovnik (Tourist Class) or Valamar Lacroma Dubrovnik (First Class) or similar.**

#### **Day 4 Dubrovnik - Kotor - Budva - Tirana**

**(B/D)**

After breakfast, guests will be taken to a beautiful city but it does not correspond to its name, Kotor, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Guests will be taken to see historical monuments within the Dirty Old Town such as the Cathedral of St. Triphon built in 1166, Pima Palace built in the 17th century, the Sea Gate of 1555, the Watch Tower, the Square of Arms and the Pillar of Shame. Next, proceed to Budva city to visit the attractions found in the Old Town of Budva located on the edge of the Adriatic Sea built during the Venetian era such as the Citadel which is now used as the theater, the Church of St. Ivan and enjoy a beautiful view over St. Island Island Nikola. Later proceed to Tirana. Dinner and check in hotel. **Overnight at Hotel Panorama Kruje (Tourist Class) or Hotel Rosa Blue (First Class) or similar.**

#### **Day 5 Tirana - Ohrid - Skopje**

**(B/D)**

After breakfast at the hotel, We will start our day with a **Guided Tour of Tirana** city like Skenderbeg Square. The name of the place was taken after the name of the Albanian hero, Gjergj Kastrioti Skenderbeu. The area has about 40,000 square meters. Later proceed to Ohrid. You will visit the sights of the city of Ohrid such as Cinar Square, Halveti Hayati Tekke, Church of St. Sophia, Amphitheater, and Kuloglu Mosque. Then, head to Skopje. Dinner and check in hotel.

#### **Day 6 Skopje - Sofia**

**(B/D)**

Breakfast at the hotel and proceed to Skopje located in Macedonia. Upon arrival there, you will embark on a **Guided City Tour of Skopje**. Highlights include a visit the Castle of Skopje, the castle and fortress inhabited since the pre-historic times of the Neolithic and early Bronze Age periods; Murat Pasha Mosque, a mosque with an exceptional design of a structure like a basilica (church) and has no dome; Yahya Pasha Mosque, a mosque built by Yahya Pasha who is the commander of Skopje and the son-in-law of Sultan Bayezid II of the Ottoman Empire government in Turkey; Stone Bridge which is a symbol of the city of Skopje was built by Sultan Mehmed II and Macedonia Square, the main square that houses the monument of Alexander The Great Statue, the monarch of Macedonia who conquered the Achaemenid empire and conquered Egypt, Persia, Babylon, Indus Valley and many more. Then, shop at the Old Bazaar. Later we proceed to Sofia, the earliest Bulgarian capital with its European and Communist-style buildings that were once ruled by Ottoman government. Dinner and hotel check-in. **Overnight at Hotel Orange Inn (Tourist Class) or Hotel Vlaho (First Class) or similar.**

**Day 7 Sofia****(B/D)**

Breakfast at the hotel, We embark on a **Guided Panoramic City Tour of Sofia**, a visit was initiated at the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral built by the son of Saint Alexander Nevsky in honor of the Russians killed in Russia-Turkey war 1877-1878 which liberated Bulgaria from the Ottoman Empire. Later proceed to visit the Ivan Vazov National Theater, Romania's oldest theater with the Neo-classic architecture. Afternoon free at leisure to explore this wonderful city. Dinner and Overnight at Hotel

**Day 8 Sofia****(B)**

Breakfast at Hotel, day free at leisure until departure transfer to Sofia Airport
