Itinerary:

Day 1 Milan - Venice (Mestre/Padova) (D)

Meet and greet upon arrival at Milan Airport and transfer to Venice (Mestre). Check in Hotel (1400hrs). Rest of the day is free at leisure. In the evening proceed for Dinner at Hotel/Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel Venezia (Tourist Class) or Best Western Hotel Bologna (First Class) or similar.**

Day 2 Venice - Milan**(B/D)**

Breakfast at Hotel. Proceed to Tronchetto where you will proceed to Venice Island on a Water Taxi. Arrive and meet your guide for your **2 hrs Walking Tour of Venice** Island which includes the Bridge of Sigh, Doges Place, St. Mark's Cathedral, Grand Canal and Rialto Bridge. Witness a glass-blower demonstrating with it's ancient art of Murano glassmaking at Venetian glass-blowing factory. Later return back to the mainland. Arrive and meet your coach and proceed to Milan via Verona. Verona is a city with a medieval old town built between the meandering Adige River. It's famous for being the setting of Shakespeare's "Romeo and Juliet." See the 14th-century residence with a tiny balcony overlooking a courtyard is said be "Juliet's House." Also you can see the Verona Arena is a huge 1st-century Roman amphitheatre, which currently hosts concerts and large-scale opera performances. Later proceed to Milan. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Ibis Hotel Milan (Tourist Class) or Idea Hotel Milano San Siro (First Class) or similar.**

Day 3 Milan - Zurich**(B/D)**

Breakfast at Hotel. Morning proceed for a **Guided Panoramic City Tour of Milan**, which highlights includes the Gothic Duomo, Glass-domed Galleria, La Scala Opera House and spend the rest of time in the bustling center around the Gothic Duomo. We proceed to Switzerland by coach. We pass through the border and take a short stop at Foxtown Retail Park. Foxtown offers 160 exclusive stores, 250 brands at factory prices. We depart by late afternoon to Zurich which will take around 3.5hrs. Arrive and proceed directly for Dinner at Restaurant. Later check in at Hotel. **Overnight at Holiday Inn Express Zurich Airport (Tourist Class) or NH Zürich Airport Hotel (First Class) or similar.**

Day 4 Zurich - Titlis - Lucerne - Zurich**(B/D)**

Breakfast at Hotel. This morning proceed to Engleberg where you will take the **Mt Titlis Tour (Admission Included)**. An adventure excursion to the highest vantage point in Central Switzerland. A pleasant ride with our deluxe motor coach takes you to the mountain resort of Engelberg in Central Switzerland, where you will board the aerial cable way for a 45 minute journey from the green valley bottom to the high alpine glacier region at 3020 m/10000 ft which guarantees snow the whole year round. Enjoy a magnificent ride in the world's first ever revolving 'ROTAIR' gondola, which offers a 360° panoramic view into the Alps. After the descent to Engelberg we board our coach for drive to Lucerne. You will get an Orientation Tour of Lucerne where you will see the Lion Monument and then Chapel Bridge. Later return to Zurich. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at (Tourist Class) or (First Class) or similar.**

Day 5 Zurich - Paris**(B/D)**

Breakfast at Hotel. Today we proceed to Paris by coach. Enjoy breathtaking views en route. It will take you around 7.5 – 8hours to get to Paris. Arrive and Dinner at Restaurant. Check in Hotel. **Overnight at Ibis Paris CDG Airport (Tourist Class) or Novotel Paris Charles De Gaulle Terminal (First Class) or similar.**

Day6 Paris**(B,D)**

Breakfast at Hotel. Today we proceed for a **Guided Panoramic City Tour of Paris** with Notre-Dame Cathedral, one of the world-famous churches with very fine French Gothic architecture. Next proceed to see the Louvre Museum, the world's largest museum known for its glass pyramid design, Les Invalides, where the tomb of Napoleon Bonaparte is stored, the Palais Garnier, the Opera House used to be the site of filming The Phantom of The Opera, and not except for the Arc de Triomphe, located at the western end of the Champs-Elysees in honor of those who fought during the Napoleonic Wars. Visit Place de la Concorde, the plains with Louis Quinze style structures, and the open-air Trocadero Square, which is the best place to take a picture of the Eiffel Tower built in the 1889 World's Fair as high as 324m. Entrance to **Eiffel Tower 2nd Level (Admission Included)**. Later proceed for shopping at Galeries Lafayette, the haven of paradise and haute couture fashion hub with its dome and modern architectural structure. Dinner at Restaurant. Overnight at Hotel

Day7 Paris - Brussels - Amsterdam**(B/D)**

Breakfast at hotel. This morning we will proceed to Amsterdam via Brussels. We will reach Brussels the Belgian capital known for its chocolate. Upon arriving in Brussels. Orientation tour of Brussels where you will visit Atomium, a tower with 9 spheres linked to atomic form, Grand Place, Europe's prettiest plains

surrounded by City Hall and Brussels City Hall, as well as icons the most important of the city of Brussels Manneken Pis, the sculpture of a little boy who threw the water into a fountain pool. Later we proceed to Amsterdam. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Ibis Amsterdam Airport (Tourist Class) or Best Western Amsterdam Airport Hotel (First Class) or similar.**

Day 8 Amsterdam - Zaanse Schans – Amsterdam (B/D)

Breakfast at Hotel, We start our day with a visit to Zaanse Schans, the old village of north Holland. It is the location of the windmills synonymous with the icon of the Dutch state and the old houses of the 18th and 19th centuries restored and preserved in its antique features. Guests have the opportunity to taste the world's best cheese at Catharina Hoeve Cheese Farm, the Bakery Museum which still operates and produces pastry-based products and Clog Workshop, which is a popular wooden clogging workshop in the Netherlands for 700 years. We return to Amsterdam and visit Coaster Diamonds where you will be explained about the process of diamond production. Next, experience unique Canal Cruise trails down the canal in Amsterdam and see the boats, historic buildings and the remains of the medieval fortress. Some free time to explore Damrak Square where you can take photos in front of the Royal Palace, one of the three Dutch palaces ever occupied by King Louis Bonaparte and the National Monument, a memorial built in conjunction with the Second World War. Dinner at Restaurant. Overnight at Hotel

Day 9 Amsterdam (B)

Breakfast at Hotel. Day free at leisure until departure transfer to Amsterdam Airport
(In case departure flight is from Dusseldorf/Frankfurt/Brussels Airport - Please add additional Euro 400 for coach transfer for the whole group)
