Day 1 Milan

(D)

On arrival we proceed for a **Guided Panoramic City Tour of Milan**, which highlights includes the Gothic Duomo, Glass-domed Galleria, La Scala Opera House and spend the rest of time in the bustling center around the Gothic Duomo. Some free time for shopping in Milan. Later check in Hotel. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Ibis Hotel Milan (Tourist Class) or Idea Hotel Milano San Siro (First Class) or similar.**

Day 2 Milan - Nice

(B/D)

Breakfast at Hotel, We will proceed to Nice. Arrive and free to explore the city of Nice. Nice, is located on the

French Riviera, sits on the pebbly shores of the Baie des Anges. Founded by the Greeks and later a retreat for 19th-century European elite, the city has also long attracted artists. Former resident Henri Matisse is honored with a career-spanning collection of paintings at Musée Matisse. Nice has a cosmopolitan Riviera vibe, and you'll enjoy exploring its fashionable boutiques and restaurants and sunning yourself on its popular beaches. Walk up to Castle Hill for a beautiful view of the city, the Bay of Angels and of course, the bright blue water that gave the Cote d'Azur its name. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel ibis Styles Nice Aéroport Arenas (Tourist Class) or Park Inn by Radisson Nice (First Class) or similar.**

Day 3 Nice - Monaco - Cannes - Nice

Breakfast at Hotel. Today a Full Day Orientation tour. First we proceed to St. Paul de Vence, which discovered by artists and celebrities in the 1930's, who tried to preserve the reclusive nature of Saint Paul, the community is now an open secret. After that proceed to Cannes - stroll the Boulevard de la Croisette lined with expensive boutiques on one side and a beautiful sandy beach on the other. In the afternoon transfer Monaco - the one-square-mile independent country to visit its castle area at a church where Princess Grace Kelly is buried and the Royal Palace grounds is located. Proceed to the fashionable district of Monte Carlo. You may wish to visit the world-renowned 'rich and famous' Grand Casino (optional) and try your luck in it. Dinner at Restaurant. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 4 Nice - Pisa

(B/D)

Breakfast at Hotel, Today we will depart to Pisa. Enjoy breathtaking views enroute. Arrive in Pisa and you will be taken to the coach parking in Pisa where you will have to take a shuttle bus to and from Leaning Tower of Pisa (Coaches are restricted to enter this area). Proceed to Leaning Tower of Pisa - explore the Square of Miracles and to marvel at one of the finest ensembles of church buildings which includes the renowned Leaning Tower. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel Capitol (Tourist Class) or NH Cavalieri (First Class) or similar.**

Day 5 Pisa - Florence - Venice

(B/D)

Breakfast at Hotel. Today morning proceed to Florence. In Florence, we will go on to explore Michelangelo Square and the famous Statue of David where you will have a breathtaking and the most beautiful scenic view of this ancient city. Some free time to explore Florence. After that we will be heading to Venice - a romantic city-on-the-sea. Dinner at Hotel. **Overnight at Hotel Venezia (Tourist Class) or Best Western Hotel Bologna (First Class) or similar.**

Day 6 Venice - San Marino

Breakfast at Hotel. Today is an interesting day. Enjoy yourself by a private water taxi to the floating Venice Island. Commence a **Guided Walking tour** which includes the Bridge of Sighs, Doge's Place, St. Mark's Cathedral, Grand Canal and Rialto Bridge. Later return back to the mainland. Then continue to San Marino - San Marino - the oldest constitutional republic in the world still in existence today. Arrive and Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel La Grotta (Tourist Class) or Hotel Sanmarino iDesign (First Class) or similar.**

Day 7 San Marino - Assisi - Rome

Breakfast at Hotel. San Marino - Perched on the hill top, protected by ramparts and defence towers, the old town is a pleasant experience to stroll and shop for interesting souvenirs and Moscato mines. Enjoy the panoramic view! After that travel to Assisi for a **Guided Panoramic City tour**. You may stroll the pleasant country town of Assisi from end to end passing first through Porta Nuova, stopping at Saint Clare Church for a superb view of the surrounding countryside, admiring the Temple of Minerva at Piazza del Comune before arriving at the unique two-tier Church of Saint Francis. See the Basilica with its Giotto fresco and enjoy the view from its medieval ramparts. In the afternoon travel to Rome, the capital city of Italy also known as the Eternal City built on Seven Hills. Dinner at Restaurant. **Overnight at Hotel De La Ville Relais (Tourist Class) or Best Western Hotel Rome Airport (First Class) or similar.**

Day 8 Rome

(B/D)

Breakfast at Hotel. Today morning we proceed on a **Guided Panoramic City Tour of Rome** to the world's smallest sovereign state - Vatican City with its famous St. Peter's Basilica (**include Vatican Museum &**

Sistine Chapel), the largest church in the world. Continue the tour to the Colosseum, Roman Forum and make a wish at Trevi Fountain before proceeding to admire the Spanish Steps. Dinner at Restaurant. Overnight at Hotel.
