Tour Itinerary

Saturday

Day 1: Arrive Zagreb

Check-in at your overnight hotel in Zagreb area.

Sunday

Day 2: Zagreb (B)

Guided sightseeing tour of Zagreb, featuring the views of historic Upper Town, St Mark's Church, St. Catherine's Church, the Cathedral, Parliament and the Government Palace. Overnight in Zagreb area.

Monday

Day 3: Zagreb – Postojna – Ljubljana (B)

Transfer to Postojna. Optionally, you will have the chance to visit to the breathtaking Postojna cave system. A ride by electrical train is followed by a guided walk through a series of cave halls with drop stones, pillars and translucent curtains that create unforgettable impressions. Do not miss the chance to see the famous Proteus Anguinus, or "human fish" as it is popularly called here. Transfer to Ljubljana for overnight.

Tuesday

Day 4: Ljubljana – Bled - Ljubljana (B)

Transfer to Bled, where you will explore this beautiful Alpine pearl on your own. Walk along the lakeshore or visit the imposing Bled Castle for a breathtaking view of Bled Lake. Do not miss the chance to take a traditional Pletna boat ride and ring the wishing bell in the small church on the island. Transfer back to Ljubljana, where an experienced local guide will

Wednesday

Day 5: Ljubljana – Ptuj – Maribor (B)

Transfer to Ptuj, the oldest town in Slovenia, which has been inhabited from Roman times. Nowadays, the town is famous for its castle, which you can visit on your own. Transfer to Maribor for overnight.

Thursday

Day 6: Maribor – Vienna (B)

Maribor is the second biggest Slovenian city, nestled in the foothills of Pohorje. See the majestic Gothic Cathedral, visit the lively Main Square and discover the legends of the Franciscan Church. Descend to the Drava river bank to see the oldest wine tree in the world (listed in the Guinness book or records). Transfer to Vienna for overnight.

Friday

Day 7: Vienna (B)

Explore the glorious Vienna – once the center of the powerful Habsburg Empire. Spend the day sightseeing, shopping or just enjoying a piece of famous Sacher cake. Overnight in Vienna area.

Saturday

Day 8: VIENNA – BUDAPEST (B)

Transfer to Budapest, where you will have the chance to explore this city on your own. Discover the royal palace in the Buda part or cross the Danube River to walk around the vivid Pest. Optionally, you will have the chance to take a Danube cruise and admire the city from this perspective. Overnight in Budapest area.
