Day 01 Arrival at Hongkong

Detailed Itinerary:

On arrival at Hong Kong International Airport, head to MTR Customer Service Centre, Level 5, Arrival Hall, redeem a round trip Airport Express Train paper ticket. From airport, the train departs every 10 minutes between 05:54 to 00:48. Relax on the 24-minute journey into HK and get off at Kowloon Station. Then take free Airport Express Shuttle bus K5 to Rosedale Hotel Kowloon (5 stops). The bus leaves in every 20 minute from 06:12 to 23:12.

The hotel you will stay for is Rosedale Hotel Kowloon. It is a modern and stylish 4-star business hotel located in the busy district of Tai Kok Tsui, Kowloon. 10 minute walking distance from Exit B of MTR Olympic station.

- OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR TODAY -

TEMPLE STREET

Known as Men's Street. It is a street located in the areas of Jordan and Yau Ma Tei in Kowloon. Popular with tourists and locals, The market starts at 2 p.m. in the afternoon, but is lively at dusk daily. There are carts bulging with goods from clothing to mobile phones and watches. Stalls have items mainly for men, jeans, t-shirts, pants, lighters, shoes, condoms and men's accessories. Like in other night markets in South East Asia, prices can always be negotiated by bargaining.

TUNG CHOI STREET

Known as Ladies' Market or Ladies' Street. It is a street situated between Boundary Street and Dundas Street in Mong Kok, Kowloon. It is one of the most well-known street markets in Hong Kong, where various kinds of products are available for cheap prices (not just for women, as its name suggests).

Day 02 Hong Kong City Tour

Detailed Itinerary:

Your tour guide will pick you up at the hotel lobby at around 12:50PM, you will begin your amazing afternoon and night tour Hong Kong. It is a coach tour + ride + dinner cruise combination package, and you will be back to your hotel at about 22:00PM.

- HIGHLIGHTS -

PEAK TRAM RIDE

Operated for over 125 years, there's nothing in the world like riding the 373 meters long Peak Tram to visit the Victoria Peak. Many skyscrapers buildings you passed by look like they leaning at a 45 degree angle!

THE SKY TERRACE

Standing at 428 metres above sea level, it is the highest viewing platform in Hong Kong offering a stunning 360-degree panoramic view across Hong Kong, including the Victoria Harbour.

ABERDEEN FISHING VILLAGE

Aberdeen Typhoon Shelter is an old traditional fishing village which is hard to find in any other parts of the World. You may gain a deeper insight of the lifestyle of Hong Kong fishing folks by riding on a sampan (at your own expenses).

STANLEY MARKET

Stanley market is a Shoppers' Paradise where you can find a wide variety of souvenirs such as silk, garments, sportswear, Chinese artwork and accessories.

TSIM SHA TSUI

Tsim Sha Tsui is one of the main shopping areas in Hong Kong. It is a giant world bazaar, where Hong Kong's glittering harbour is met by an alternate sea of stalls, shops, markets and malls.

AVENUE OF STARS

The Hollywood style Avenue of Stars features plaques for honoured movie celebrities on the walk of fame. It also features milestones and sculptures about Hong Kong film industry, along with kiosks selling souvenirs. The Avenue of Stars has been closed from Oct 8th, 2015 onwards for repair and improvement works. It will be re-open in 2017/2018.

STAR FERRY

The Star Ferry is the oldest means of transportation in Hong Kong, as it begins carrying passengers across the Victoria Harbour in the late 19th century. It still carries over 26 million passengers a year today, and you will get a chance to experience this unique way of crossing the harbour with us on the tour.

OLD CLOCK TOWER

The Clock Tower was part of former Kowloon Station of Kowloon-Canton Railway since 1915. The main terminus building was demolished in 1978 leaving only the clock tower. It is a landmark from the Age of Steam and has been listed as a declared monument in Hong Kong since 1990.

HARBOUR CRUISE BAUHINIA

Savor a sumptuous buffet dinner while a live band plays aboard the restaurant cruise liner - Harbour Cruise Bauhinia. Dance the night away, or relax and enjoy a view of the glittering city and the magnificent harbour.

A SYMPHONY OF LIGHTS

A symphony of lights has been awarded the world's "Largest Permanent Light Show" by Guinness World Records. While having buffet on the cruise, you can see this magnificent show over the Victoria Harbour. The show combines interactive lights of 45 key buildings on both Hong Kong Island and Kowloon.

Hong Kong Disneyland is located on the Lantau Island of Hong Kong. The park opened to visitors on 12th September, 2005. The park consists of six themed areas: Main Street, USA, Fantasyland, Adventureland, Tomorrowland, Toy Story Land and Grizzly Gulch. The park currently occupies 22.4 hectares and will be expanded to 27.5 hectares when the 2 new themed areas are completed.

- HIGHLIGHTS -

FANTASY LAND

Journey into the realm of imagination where anything is possible and fairytales come to life. Experience happily ever after as you meet the Disney Princesses, soar through the air with Dumbo in the land of where dreams do come true.

Day 04 Hong Kong to Shenzhen to Hong Kong

Detailed Itinerary: Hotel pickup and coach transfer to Hung Hom railway station by a coach with English speaking tour guide, take First class train ticket Hong Kong to Shenzhen.

After our tour in Shenzhen finishes, take a first-class train at approx. 6:00PM with your Hong Kong tour guide, and you will be back to hotel at about 8:30PM to 9:00PM.

- HIGHLIGHTS -

SHENZHEN MUSEUM OF HISTORY & FOLK CENTER

Shenzhen Museum has more than 20,000 pieces of cultural relics, showing the civilization of China and historic materials about the development history of Shenzhen. (Note: Shenzhen Museum closes on every Monday. Tour will visit Meridian View Centre on Monday.)

THE EXHIBITION OF SHENZHEN FOLK CULTURE

“Folk Culture” refers to a culture traditionally practiced by a small, rural group living in relative isolation from other groups. This exhibition hall allows you to explore specific folk culture of ancient Shenzhen residents, mainly the Cantonese and Hakka community.

MODERN SHENZHEN EXHIBITION

The Exhibition of Modern Shenzhen mainly presents Shenzhen’s history spanning from Kowloon Sea-base battle in 1839 to the establishment of PRC in 1949. This exhibition focuses on two main themes, battle against invasion and development of social economy. Tour includes a visit to Shenzhen arts and craft center, where some of the World’s best hand-crafts products are made.

THEME PARKS

You can choose Plan A or Plan B from the following:

Plan A - SPLENDID CHINA & CHINA FOLK CULTURE VILLAGES

China Folk Culture Villages is the first large-scale cultural & scenic spot assembling folk arts, customs, folk villages. With an area of 200 thousand square meters; It reflects the colorful Chinese culture in many respects.

Adjoining to the China Folk Culture Village. Includes more than 70 famous scenic wonders of China in Miniature. This is the world's largest display of miniature landmarks.

Plan B – WINDOW OF THE WORLD

One of the most famous tourist destinations in Shenzhen. Here you can see vivid replicas of the world’s wonders, historical heritages and famous scenic sites.

DIM SUM LUNCH AT SHANGRI-LA HOTEL

After visiting the Museum of History and Folk Center, we have specially arranged a traditional dim-sum lunch for your stomach at the world famous Shangri-La hotel. (Shang Palace).

Day 05 Hong Kong to Macau to Hong Kong

Detailed Itinerary:

Our English speaking tour guide will pick you up between 07:50 to 08:10. Every day, we pickup from 100+ hotels in Hong Kong Island and Kowloon. You will take our coach to ferry terminal, take 1 hour ferry to Macau.

The tour ends at 4pm. We will be transferred to Macau Ferry, you can choose:

- Option 1

Take 5pm ferry to Hong Kong, and then take coach back to your hotel

- Option 2

Take 10pm ferry back to Hong Kong. (At 16:30, take free hotel shuttle bus from Macau Ferry to Venetian Macao. Free shuttle bus leaves every 15 minute. At 21:00, take free bus back to Macau Ferry. At 23:00, take a taxi back to hotel at own cost).

Please tell us if you choose option 1 or option 2 on reservation.

- HIGHLIGHTS -

TEMPLE OF A-MA (UNESCO HERITAGE)

The temple was built 400 years ago in homage to a girl who saved A seamen's life. The temple is one of the most famous Taoist temples. Macau was later named by the Portugese settlers in mid-16th Century. This temple has become a World Heritage in 2005.

RUINS OF ST. PAUL'S

In the heart of the old city stands the great carved stone facade of St. Paul's, which, with the grand staircase, are all that remain of the first church and Colleague of the Jesuits in China. Designed by an Italian Jesuit, the church was built in the early 17th century. In 1835 a fire destroyed all but the facade.

NA TCHA TEMPLE (UNESCO HERITAGE)

This Chinese traditional styled temple known as Na Tcha Temple was built for worshipping Na Tcha (a mythical character). The temple was enlisted as a World Heritage in 2005. The temple is located just behind the Ruins of St. Pauls.

SECTION OF THE OLD CITY WALLS (UNESCO HERITAGE)

This surviving segment of City Wall was built in 1569. It is a remnant of an early Portuguese tradition of constructing defensive walls around their port settlements. It was enlisted as a World Heritage in 2005.

MOUNT FORTRESS (UNESCO HERITAGE)

The fortress was Macau's principal military defense structure which was built in conjunction with the Jesuits from 1617 to 1626. The fortress covers an area of 10,000 square metres and is in the shape of a trapezoid. It has become a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005.

MACAU TOWER (Admission on own expenses)

Soar to a breathtaking 223 meters above the ground. Macau Tower offers you a different vision of the entire city. Gaze out over to Cotai Strip, look for Macau's landmarks and historical sites all in one spot.

It offers the best view of Macau and has been awarded "Best Theme Attraction in Asia Pacific" for 2005 & 2006 by TTTG Asia – Macau Tower. For those with fear of heights, there are also souvenirs shops, Mocha clubs (machine based casino gaming) and coffee shops located at the ground floor.

Optional Macau Tower @ HKD120/adult & HKD70/child or senior (aged 65 or above).

CASINO

Casinos in Macau offer a large variety of casino games that give versatile entertainment to visitors. Try your luck! No picture taking is allowed inside the Casino. We will visit SANDS CASINO.

- OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES TODAY -

POTTINGER STREET

Pottinger Street, known as the Stone Slabs Street by the locals. The street was named after Henry Pottinger, the first Governor of Hong Kong in 1858. There are many small local shops placed aside the stone steps. It is also a place of selling nostalgia. Taiwan Director Ang Lee's award winning "Lust, Caution" was partly filmed at here)

MID-LEVEL ESCALATORS

Serving as a method of transporting, it links Des Voeux Road in Central with Conduit Road in the Mid-levels. It cost HKD240 million to build. The entire system covers over 800 metres in distance and it is the longest outdoor covered escalator system in the world.

Take Airport Express to hotel. From airport, the train departs every 10 minutes between 05:54 to 00:48.

If your arrival flight time is earlier before 06:00, or later than 23:00, please arrange your airport/hotel transfer by yourself. The extra cost for airport to hotel private transfer by a 7-seater van working between 2300 to 0700 is USD130 one way. The taxi fare is about USD70. Please notice this extra transfer fare will be paid by you.

Take Airport Express Shuttle Bus / Train to airport. From Kowloon Station: The first train leaves at 05:53, the last train leaves at 00:52.
