

## **Golden Triangle with Kerala Tour** **10 Nights / 11 days**

### **Day 1: Arrival at Delhi**

On arrival at Delhi, Indira Gandhi international airport, meet and greet by our representative. Later, assistance and transfer to hotel for overnight stay in Delhi.

Delhi – the capital of India, is a fascinating city with complexities and contradictions, beauty and dynamism, where the past co-exists with the present. Many dynasties ruled from here and the city is rich in the architecture of its monuments. Delhi is not only the present metropolis of India but also a Necropolis, Because of its location, being on the banks of the River Yamuna, many cities have risen and fallen over the last five millenniums.

### **Day 2: Delhi Full day city tour**

Morning enjoy your breakfast at hotel. After breakfast you will transfer to visit Old & New Delhi

Visit some of the interesting sites of Delhi such as, Qutub Minar, Humayun's Tomb, Drive past President's House, India Gate, and Red fort (visit from outside). Later also visit Jamma Masjid & enjoy Rickshaw ride at Chandni Chowk, visit Raj Ghat - cremation site of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the Nation, Lotus Temple, Lakshmi Narayan Temple.

Overnight in Delhi.

### **Day 3: Delhi - Agra (205 Kms/ 5 Hrs)**

Morning start your journey to the Taj City, AGRA. On arrival at Agra and proceed to your hotel.

**Agra** is famous as the home to one of the Seven Wonders of the World – the Taj Mahal. The architectural splendor of the mausoleums, the fort and the palaces in Agra is a vivid reminder of the opulence of the legendary Mughal Empire. Agra was their capital for nearly a hundred years from 1564. A pleasant town, with a comparatively easy pace, Agra is known for its superb inlay work on marble and soapstone by artisans who are hereditary craft persons. The city is also famous for its carpets, gold thread embroidery and leather shoes.

Later visit Agra city, visits include the Taj Mahal – the inimitable poem in white marble. Built over a period of 22 years, by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in 1630, for his Queen Mumtaz Mahal to enshrine her mortal remains, it is one of the seven modern wonders of the World. **[The Taj is closed on every Friday].**

Visit Itmad – Ud – Daula Tomb & Agra Fort built by three Mughal Emperors starting from Akbar the Great in 1565 AD, which is a masterpiece of design and construction. Within the fort are a number of exquisite buildings including the Moti Masjid, Jahangir's Palace, Khaas Mahal and the Sheesh Mahal, Diwane-i-Am, Diwane-i-Khas and Musamman Burj, where Emperor Shah Jahan, the fifth Mughal Emperor died a prisoner.

Overnight in Agra

### **Day 4: Agra - Jaipur via Fatehpur Sikri (245 kms/ 5 ½ hrs)**

After breakfast at hotel drive to Jaipur en route visit of Fatehpur Sikri – this exquisite city built by Akbar the Great in 1569, in red sandstone, with its forts, palaces and mosques was abandoned 14 years after its creation due to political reasons. The Diwane-i-

Am – a vast courtyard in which the emperor gave daily public audience; Diwane-i-Khas – a large quadrangle which contained all the major functions of the Palace, Pachisi court, the Emperors private living quarter, Jodha Bhai's Palace, Mariam's Palace, Birbal's Palace, Hawa Mahal and Panch Mahal are some of the important buildings of this residential complex. The Friday Mosque and the exquisite tomb of Sheik Salim Chisti are in the religious grounds set aside in a separate enclosure adjacent to the secular buildings.

Continue drive to Jaipur.

Arrive Jaipur and check-in to hotel.

**Jaipur** – the capital of Rajasthan is color washed pink – the color associated with hospitality in Rajput culture. This Pink City of fairy tale palaces, rugged fortresses perched on barren hills and broad avenues are picturesque. The first planned city of its time, a formidable wall encircles Jaipur.

Overnight in Jaipur

#### **Day 5: Jaipur full day tour**

Morning: enjoy your breakfast at the hotel

After breakfast you will proceed for the excursion to Amber Fort, here you will enjoy the Elephant Ride to reach atop of the palace. Continue your tour: with the city tour of Jaipur- visiting Maharaja's City Palace, the former Royal residence, part of it converted into a museum. Later visit the Jantar Mantar, which is the largest stone and marble crafted observatory in the world, having 17 large instruments, many of them still in working condition. During the tour you will also have a brief photography stop at Hawa Mahal - the Palace of Winds. Also visit Albert Hall.

Overnight in Jaipur

#### **Day 06: Jaipur – Cochin Via Ahmedabad / Mumbai /Delhi**

Morning breakfast at Hotel. Later on time transfer to airport to board flight for Cochin. On arrival, transfer to hotel.

Evening enjoy Kathakali dance. Overnight in Cochin.

#### **Day 7: Cochin – Munnar (140 kms / 04 Hrs)**

After breakfast, half day sightseeing tour of Cochin. Places of interest are Dutch Palace, Jewish Synagogue, Fort Kochi beach, Chinese Fishing Net. Later check out from the hotel and drive to Munnar. On the way visit tea and spice plantations, Cheeyappara waterfalls, view point etc (IF TIME PERMITS). Arrive Munnar and check in your hotel. Rest of the day free for your own activities.

Overnight in Munnar. .

#### **Day 8: Munnar City Tour**

After Breakfast at Hotel, you will proceed for sightseeing of Munnar. Places & Activities of Interest –Munnar Tea gardens, Munnar Tea museum & Tea factory, Munnar Elephant Ride, Pothamedu View Point, Hydel Park, Photo Shooting Points, Tea Powder Shopping. Overnight in Munnar.

#### **Day 9: Munnar – Thekkady/Periyar (110 kms / 2.2 hrs)**

After Breakfast at Hotel, proceed to Thekkady. On arrival check in at hotel & relax. Afternoon, proceed for sightseeing – The Periyar wildlife sanctuary is thick evergreen forest, declared a Tiger Reserve in 1978. The splendid artificial lake formed by the Mullaperiyar Dam across the Periyar river adds to the charm of the park. Enjoy boat ride in periyar national park. Overnight in Thekkady.

#### **Day 10: Thekkady/Periyar – Alleppey (170kms / 3.4 hrs)**

After breakfast at Hotel, you will proceed to Alleppey/Alappuzha, connected as Venice of the East by Lord Curzon. The place is well known for its meandering canals, brackish lagoons & sprawling Backwaters.

The prominent Tourist attractions are the Kerala Houseboats, popularly known as Kettuvallams. You may opt a cruising Houseboat or a Hotel for Overnight Stay.

Overnight stay in Hotel.

**Day 11: Alleppey – Cochin (72kms/ 2hrs)**

After Breakfast at Hotel, checkout and transfer to Cochin Airport to board flight for onwards destination.
