Brief itinerary:

Day 1) Arrival in Kathmandu Airport and sightseeing tour of Bhaktapur and drive to Nagarkot.

Day 2) Enjoy Sunrise in the morning in Nagarkot. Transfer back to Kathmandu and sightseeing of Boudhanath Stupa & Kathmandu Durbar Square.

Day 3) Transfer to Pokhara from Kathmandu. Evening boating in Fewa Lake. Overnight at a hotel.

Day 4) Half day sightseeing of Pokhara. Afternoon free on leisure to explore Lake Side area. Overnight at a hotel.

Day 5) Transfer back to Kathmandu and free for the day on leisure.

Day 6) Transfer to Airport for departure.

Detail Itinerary:

Day 1 Kathmandu - Nagarkot: (D) 1.5 hrs drive

Upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport our representatives will be present at the arrival gate of the Airport with your name written in a placard. Warm welcome to our guests and proceed for sightseeing tour

Drive to **Bhaktapur Durbar Square, (UNESCO World heritage site)**. Bhaktapur is one the oldest city in Kathmandu which is filled with ancient arts and architectures, temples and old buildings which will surely charm our visitors. Bhaktapur is filled with monuments, most terra-cotta with carved wood columns, palaces and temples with elaborate carvings, gilded roofs, and open courtyards. The city is dotted with pagodas and religious shrines. The Art Gallery has a fascinating collection of ancient manuscripts, Thangkas, centuries-old stone sculpture, antique paintings that belong to the Hindu and Buddhist traditions of various periods.

After Bhaktapur, drive to **Nagarkot** which is at a height of 2300m above the sea level. From this beautiful highland you can catch excellent views of sunset and sunrise and gorgeous mountain ranges including Mt. Everest on a clear day.

Day 2 Nagarkot – Kathmandu (B/L/D) 1.5 hrs drive)

Wake up early morning and enjoy the mesmerizing sunrise and the beautiful Himalayan Panoramas just in front of you. Enjoy the fascination scenery and enjoy your breakfast.

Guest may wish to have some walk in the village side near your hotel. Then we will drive back to Kathmandu and continue the sightseeing Tour.

Proceed for sightseeing tour **of Great Stupa of Boudhanath (UNESCO World heritage site)**. Boudhanath Stupa holds a great importance to the entire Buddhist around the world. The Stupa is a vast dome-shaped monument representing the Mind of the Buddha, is the primary pilgrimage destination for Tantric Buddhists of the Himalayas and a major draw for Tibetan Buddhists from all over the planet. The history of the Stupa from its origins in the fifth century to the present day is also presented here for the first time.

Next sightseeing is **Kathmandu Durbar Square, (UNESCO World heritage site)**. Kathmandu Durbar Square is the historic place that was also a politically important site until recently. The Kings of Nepal were crowned and their coronation ceremony was solemnized in this durbar square. The Durbar Square, with its old temples and palaces, epitomizes the religious and cultural life of the

people. The temples, monuments, and palaces are believed to have been built by the Malla kings of the Medieval Nepal.

Day 3 Kathmandu – Pokhara (B/L/D) 6 hrs drive

After breakfast, drive to Pokhara which is the second largest and the most beautiful city in Nepal. Upon arrival check in to the hotel and proceed for **boating in Fewa Lake**. In the evening free time to explore on your own.

Day 4 Pokhara (B/L/D)

A half day tour of Pokhara is in store for you which includes visiting **old market of Pokhara, World Peace Pagoda, Davis Fall & Tibetan Refugee Camp**. After the city tour, free time to explore the wonderful lake side area. Guest can find various shopping items and also can chill out in lake side cool and cozy cafe or pubs.

Day 5 Pokhara - Kathmandu (B/L/D) 6 hrs drive

After breakfast drive to Kathmandu. On reaching Kathmandu check in to the hotel and free time to explore on your own or rest and relax.

In the evening we will drive to an **authentic Nepalese restaurant for farewell dinner with cultural show**.

Day 6 Departure Kathmandu (B)

Drive to airport for flight back home with lots of memories of Nepal.
