### **Brief Itinerary:**

Day 1) Arrival in Kathmandu Airport. Half day sightseeing of Boudhanath Stupa & Kathmandu Durbar Square. Overnight at a hotel.

Day 2) Transfer to Pokhara. Boating in the evening.

Day 3) Half day sightseeing of Pokhara. Afternoon leisure to explore the lake city.

Day 4) Drive to Chitwan National Park. Cultural dance in the evening.

Day 5) Jungle activities in Chitan National Park. Overnight at a Ressort.

Day 6) Transfer back to Kathmandu and drive to Nagarkot. Overnight at a hotel.

Day 7) Morning transfer back to Kathmandu. Afternoon sightseeing of Swoyambhunath Stupa & Patan Durbar Square. Overnight at a hotel

Day 8) Transfer to Airport for departure.

### **Detailed Itinerary:**

#### **Day 1 Kathmandu (D)**

Upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, our representatives will be present at the arrival gate of the Airport with your name written in a placard. Warm welcome to our guests and continue for sightseeing.

Proceed for sightseeing tour to **Great Stupa of Boudhanath (UNESCO World heritage site)**. Boudhanath Stupa holds a great importance to the entire Buddhist around the world. The Stupa is a vast dome-shaped monument representing the Mind of the Buddha, is the primary pilgrimage destination for Tantric Buddhists of the Himalayas and a major draw for Tibetan Buddhists from all over the planet. The history of the Stupa from its origins in the fifth century to the present day is also presented here for the first time. Our next destination is **Kathmandu durbar square, (UNESCO World heritage site)**. Kathmandu Durbar Square is the historic place that was also a politically important site until recently. The Kings of Nepal were crowned and their coronation ceremony was solemnized in this durbar square. The Durbar Square, with its old temples and palaces, epitomizes the religious and cultural life of the people. The temples, monuments, and palaces are believed to have been built by the Malla kings of the Medieval Nepal.

#### **Day 2 Kathmandu – Pokhara (B/L/D) 6 hrs drive**

After breakfast, drive to Pokhara which is the second largest and the most beautiful city in Nepal. Upon arrival check in to the hotel and proceed for **boating in Fewa Lake**. In the evening free time to explore on your own.

#### **Day 3 Pokhara (B/L/D)**

A half day tour of Pokhara is in store for you, which includes visiting **old market of Pokhara, World Peace Pagoda, Davis Fall and Tibetean Refugee Camp**. After the city tour, free time to explore the wonderful lake side area. Guest can find various shopping items and also can chill out in lake side cool and cozy cafe or pubs.

#### Day 4 Pokhara - Chitwan (B/L/D) 4.5 hrs drive

After breakfast, drive to Chitwan. Chitwan offers one of **the finest wildlife experiences in Asia**. In the evening proceed for cultural show which is known as Tharu stick dance.

#### Day 5 Chitwan Jungle Activities (B/L/D)

Today guests will be escorted by expert naturalist on various exciting activities including **elephant back safari, Canoe ride, Jungle walk, Bird watching, Slide show**.

#### Day 6 Chitwan – Kathmandu – Nagarkot (B/L/D) 6 hrs drive

After breakfast drive to Kathmandu and continue to **Nagarkot** which is at a height of 2300m above the sea level. From this beautiful highland you can catch excellent views of sunset and sunrise and gorgeous mountain ranges including Mt. Everest on a clear day.

#### Day 7 Nagarkot – Kathmandu (B/L/D) 1.5 hrs drive

Wake up early morning and enjoy the mesmerizing sunrise and the beautiful Himalayan Panoramas just in front of you. Enjoy the fascination scenery and enjoy your breakfast.

Guest may wish to have some walk in the village side near your hotel. Then we will drive back to Kathmandu and continue the sightseeing Tour.

Proceed for half day sightseeing to the 2000 years old Swoyambhunath Stupa, (**UNESCO World heritage site**) sometimes also known as the monkey temple. The temple charms with its great dazzling Stupa, while at the same time offers a marvelous view of Kathmandu Valley.

Next destination is **Patan Durbar square (UNESCO World heritage site)**. Patan Durbar Square complex is perhaps the most photographed of the three durbar squares. Located in the heart of Patan city, this was once the palace of the kings of Patan. The square is a display of Newari architecture that had reached its pinnacle during the reign of Malla kings who were great builders and patrons of the arts.

In the evening we will drive to an **authentic Nepalese restaurant for farewell dinner with cultural show**.

#### Day 8 Departure Kathmandu (B)

Drive to airport for flight back home.
