Kyushu is packed with a diversity of hot springs, natural environments, shopping and sheer fun. JR Kyushu operates the railway network that brings it all together. Enjoy a journey through Kyushu by railway, on trains highly rated for both comfort and design.

Unlimited rail travel throughout the designated Kyushu area, on both local and limited express trains. The All Kyushu Area Rail Pass can also be used for Kyushu Shinkansen "Mizuho", "Sakura" and "Tsubame" trains.

Child prices apply to children 6 – 11 years old as of the date on which the exchange order is issued.

Who is eligible?

- Anyone with a passport issued by a government other than Japan
- Anyone who does not reside in Japan and is a tourist from abroad with "temporary visitor" status
- If you have a permanent resident visa in a country other than Japan, or are married to a non-Japanese and reside in a country other than Japan, you may purchase this pass at an authorized sales office such as a travel agent outside Japan, but not inside Japan.

Validity Period:

- Exchange ticket validity: Three months from issue
- Exchange sites: Hakata Station, Kokura Station, Mojiko Station; JR Kyushu Travel Agency offices in Kokura, Hakata, Kumamoto, Saga, Nagasaki, Oita, Kagoshima Chuo, Miyazaki and Miyazaki Airport stations; and the Beppu Station Travel Center.
 ※JR Kyushu Rail Passes (Northern Kyushu Area) are not available at JR Kyushu Travel Agency offices in Kagoshima or Miyazaki, Kagoshima Chuo Station, Miyazaki Station, or Miyazaki-kuko-eki (Miyazaki airport) Station.
