Day	Itinerary [6 Days Eastern Korea]
Day 1 (Monday)	<p><b>Incheon – Seoul</b></p> <p>Arrival at Incheon International Airport. Meet and greet by driver. Transfer to Seoul and check in hotel for the day. <b>Hotel: 4 star hotel (*Tmark Grand Hotel Myeongdong is the first option.)</b></p>
Day 2 (Tuesday)	<p><b>Seoul – Jinju – Busan [Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner]</b></p> <p>Meet the guide at hotel lobby. The first stop is <b>Jinjuseong Fortress</b>, historically linked to the Japanese invasion in 1592. Afterward, transfer to Busan and enjoy the rest of the day on own after dinner. <i>Rest of the day is free for you to explore Haeundae Beach known for its modern feel. You may spend fantastic night time at cafes and pubs. Also, you can enjoy watching busking along the shoreline as well as Haeundae Market.</i></p> <p>Lunch: Bulgogi stew // Dinner: Korean style BBQ <b>Hotel: 4 – 5 star hotel (*Haeundae Grand Hotel [5star] is the first option.)</b></p>
Day 3 (Wednesday)	<p><b>Busan – Gyeongju [Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner]</b></p> <p>This morning, visit <b>Nurimaru APEC House</b>, it means “a house where the world summits gather together for an APEC meeting.” Located on <b>Dongbaekseom Island</b>, which is noted for its beautiful, natural landscape accented by dense camellia and pine trees. Next, head to Gyeongju, and explore <b>Bulguksa Temple</b>, the representative relic designated as a World Cultural Asset by UNESCO in Gyeongju. And then visit <b>Gyeongju National Museum</b>. Its holdings are largely devoted to relics of the Silla kingdom, of which Gyeongju was the capital. Continue to visit <b>Daereungwon Tomb Complex</b>. This park has more than 20 large and small tombs from the Shilla period and has been designated Historic site. The tombs are presumed to be those of kings and court officials. The last stop for today, <b>Cheomseongdae Observatory</b> which is the oldest existing astronomical observatory in Asia. Constructed during the reign of Queen Seon-deok (r. 632-647), it was used to observe stars in order to forecast the weather.) After dinner, feel free to enjoy on own around walk through <b>Bomun lake</b>.</p> <p>Lunch: Vegetarian set menu // Dinner: Casual Buffet <b>Hotel: 4 – 5 star hotel (*Gyeongju Hilton Hotel [5star] is the first option.)</b></p>
Day 4 (Thursday)	<p><b>Gyeongju – Andong – Wonju – Pyeongchang [Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner]</b></p> <p>A morning tour will introduce you to <b>Andong Hahoe Village</b>, home to descendants of the Ryu clan of Pungsan and well-known for its traditional houses. Hahoe Village boasts exquisite scenic sights: the elegant Nakdong River flowing around the village, the magnificent Buyongdae Cliff, endlessly unfolding sandy beaches, and lush, ancient pine trees. Hahoe Village was added to the UNESCO World Heritage List under the category of “Historic Villages in Korea” on July 31, 2010. Next, visit <b>Hanji Theme Park</b> where you can get a chance to experience the Hanji making process. A short transfer will bring you to your hotel in Pyeongchang.</p> <p>Lunch: Braised chicken with vegetables &amp; Roasted fish // Dinner: Korean style Pork belly, Samgyeopsal <b>Hotel: 4 – 5 star hotel (*Intercontinental Pyeongchang [5star] is the first option.)</b></p>
Day 5 (Friday)	<p><b>Pyeongchang – Gangneung – Mt.Seorak – Seoul [Breakfast/ Lunch]</b></p> <p>This morning, visit <b>Ski Jump Tower Observatory</b> by monorail for Olympic Winter Games Pyeongchang 2018. Enjoy the view of the Sky Lounge and have some free time enjoying coffee or tea. Finally, travel to Yangyang for a short hiking at <b>Jujeongol of Mt. Seorak</b> to enjoy the nature. Return to Seoul around 18:00. Drop off service is available at T-Mark Grand Hotel, T-Mark Hotel, Lotte Hotel Seoul and Center Mark Hotel.</p> <p>Lunch: Set Menu with Seasoned Wild Vegetables <b>Hotel: 4 star hotel (*Tmark Grand Hotel Myeongdong is the first option.)</b></p>
Day 6 (Saturday)	<p><b>Seoul – Incheon [Breakfast]</b></p> <p>Free at leisure until time to transfer to Incheon International Airport for your flight home.</p>
