Today, visit **Osulloc Tea Museum**, the first tea museum in Korea aiming to introduce and widespread Korean tea history and its tradition. Next, visit to the biggest Camellia arboretum in the East Asia - **Camellia Hill**. See the world's most expensive teddy bear in **Teddy Bear Museum**. Visit **Jusangjeoli Cliff**, stone pillars piled up along the coast and is a designated cultural monument of Jeju Island. Thereafter, visit **Cheonjiyeon Waterfalls**, meaning "sky connected with land," appears to fall from the heavens, giving the falls its name. Lastly, visit to the largest traditional market in Seogwipo - **Seogwipo Maeil Olle Market**.
