	10:30-11:30	<b>Traditional Hanji Center.</b> (Hanji Craft Experience_Making mask with Hanji)

	12:40-14:30	<b>Andong Hahoe Folk Village</b> , one of the most famous traditional villages in Korea that was added to the list of UNESCO World Cultural Heritage. The arrangement of the old traditional houses in the village shows Confucianist social structure during the Joseon Dynasty.	
	16:30-17:30	<b>Bulguksa Temple</b> is the representative relic of Gyeongju and was designated as a World Cultural Asset by UNESCO in 1995. The beauty of the temple itself and the artistic touch of the stone relics are known throughout the world. Bulguksa Temple was built in 528 during the Silla Kingdom, in the 15th year of King Beop-Heung's reign (514-540).

Day 3 (Wednesday)	9:30	Hotel Breakfast.	
	09:30-10:30	Transfer to Pohang.	
	10:30-11:30	<b>Yeongildae Beach</b> is the largest beach on the Korea east coast, at over 400,000 m². Along with Songdo Beach, it is known as one of the most popular beaches in Pohang. It is a great place for families and friends during summer vacations. It is conveniently located with plenty of lodgings and amenities such as restaurants offering fresh seafood including sashimi.	
	11:30-12:30	<b>Pohang Jukdo Market</b> first started as a small gathering of local vendors who sold their wares at the large fields of reeds in Pohang Inner Harbor. Now, over five decades later, the market has become one of the largest traditional markets in the Gyeongsangbuk-do area (on the east coast). Along with the Pohang Jukdo Market, visitors will also find the Jukdo Fish Market, only 500m away from Ogeori (the heart of Pohang). The largest open-run market in the east, the seafood wholesale market is made up of 200 raw fish stores, offering the area's best catches.	
	12:30-13:30	Lunch at Local Restaurant with local dishes.	
	13:30-17:30	Transfer to Seoul.	
	17:30	Arrive at SM Duty Free. Hotel Check in at Center Mark Hotel or similar. Free & Easy.
