

# 6 Days Golden Tri-Angle Route Program

## Vientiane – Xieng Khuang – Luang Prabang

Valid Till: 31 Dec 2021

### **DAY 1: Vientiane (Arrival Day) (L. D)**

Upon arrival in Vientiane Capital, you will be met and transferred to your centrally located hotel. After a short rest, we see the major sights of the capital; including the oldest Wat Sisaket, the temple with thousands of miniature Buddha statues and the former royal temple of Wat Prakeo, which previously housed the famous Emerald Buddha Image. On the way to Lao's National precious heritage, the famous and sacred structure of That Luang Stupa, we stop enroute to take some pictures of the imposing Patuxay Monument, which is well known as Vientiane's own Arc de Triumph. We watch the sunset by the Mekong Riverside and spend the evening here absorbing the city at night. Overnight in Vientiane. ### **DAY 2: Vientiane - Xiengkhouang (by flight) (B / L / D)**

After Breakfast, depart for XiengKhouang by flight LK 212. XiengKhouang was devastated by American bombing between 1964 and 1973. Upon arrival, we transfer out to visit the Plain of Jars, an impressive archaeological site where hundreds of large stone jars are littered all over the plateau. We also have time, this afternoon seeing the old capital of Muang Khoun Province and the nearby villages, home to the Hmong hill tribe and Tai Dam people. ### **DAY 3 : Xiengkhouang (B / L / D)**

After breakfast, we will now be turned to westward to experience the mountains. We will climb up to see the top of Phou Kood Chom Lek (Iron mountain), where the top of the mountain was destroyed down 7 meters during the war fighting the aggressive imperialists. Then, we will be taken to sit in front of Nong Tang (Chair Pond) for coffee break and enjoy the fresh air with the atmosphere of the pond under the cliff. Then, we will visit Tham Pra the large Buddha cave, where the Buddha statue situated for more than thousand years. On the way back to Phonsavang we will stop at Phou Keng Jar Quarry site and also known as Keng Mountain, Plain of jars on a big hill. There are more than 1000 step from the bottom to the top. ### **DAY 4: Xiengkhouang – Luang Prabang (by flight) (B / L / D)**

Early morning, we visit the Central Market of Phonsavanh to watch the different hill tribe people barter and exchange merchandises. After that we will go to the Airport then, depart to Luang Prabang by flight LK 214. After checking into hotel, if time permits, we visit the impressive stupa of Wat Visoun and the shrine of Wat Aham, Wat Mai; we visit the Night Market, where you can browse a lovely selection of handmade textiles, made by the local people and hill tribe people surrounding Luang Prabang. **DAY 5 Luang Prabang (B/ L/ D)**

Wake up at dawn to watch the Buddhist Alms Giving Ceremony along Sakkaline Road near Wat Sensokharam, where monks from the monastery will collect alms from locals and tourists alike. While it may be an interesting experience, be sensitive to the culture and traditions of the Lao people, many of whom are devout Buddhists. Then climb up to Phou sy hill of 328 steps to see the view of the town. Embark on the private traditional boat for the boat trip upsteam on the Mekong River, Visit Pak Ou cave to the sacred cave of Tham Ting, crammed with thousands of gold lacquered Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes. On the way back to Luang Prabang, visit Phanom weaving village. Then continue to excursion to the fantastic waterfall Tad Kuangsy where you can splash around in the turquoise pools or walk along the forest trails. Overnight in Luang Prabang
